To continue the quotations from the Communist secret document published in Peking by the Foreign Languages Press, 1959, written by Li Wei Han. As was noted here last week, the Vatican paper L'Osservatore Romano has said that this plan was used in numerous countries including Cuba.

"This brings us to the next stage of our attack, the objective of which is the destruction of the link existing between the Church and the Vatican. (Reactionary clergy) must be reminded that their protests against (our) attacks, to which they are subjected because of links with the Vatican, are unpatriotic and are in conflict with the laws and the state. The task of our militants is to convince the masses that individuals can have their own religion without the Vatican having the right to dictate the affairs of all the Churches in the world. Our militants must also explain the principle of the coexistence of patriotism and religion. In this way the masses are alienated from those who take their cue from the Vatican, and the way is opened for the establishment of an independent Church.

"Any clerical personalities who have resisted all persuasion to conform to the wishes of the Government will be denounced at gatherings of the masses. Our militants must initiate such denunciations of these clerics and other personalities. History provides innumerable precedents proving the possibility of legal action against those who are opposed to the separation of the Church and the Vatican. St. Ann's Residents Organize for Prayer

Harnessing the power of faith is the goal of the Apostolate of Faith program being instituted by Father John Hempel at St. Ann's Home and the Heritage.

He told the 80 residents attending a regular meeting Aug. 9 that they have "the power of faith" which is "a power a lot of other people don't have." He said that the residents could use this power to benefit others.

Father Hempel, chaplain at the home for the elderly, explained to the residents that while they don't have much financial or physical power, he has seen "one power we do have here — the power of your faith." He noted that other spiritual communities have programs which involve the community praying for the intentions of petitioners. The Apostolate of Faith is such a program for the community at St. Ann's and the Heritage, he said, a program that could benefit the larger community outside St. Ann's.

For the program to work, people outside the home must be made aware of "our concern for their problems," Father Hempel said. "We can't start it until we get some petitions," he noted, and he hopes that persons around the diocese will send their petitions to him at St. Ann's.

the arguments necessary to convince the Catholic intellectuals that a break with the Vatican is a step forward. The legal provisions of the Constitution of the People's Republic protecting all religions, and the history of the different Protestant movements will help to convince these intellectuals.

"Simultaneously, our militants will have the task of inducing the Catholic associations to unite in a unanimous demand that the People's Government should authorize the setting up of an independent Church in order to cleanse the Catholic associations of any unpatriotic stigma caused by a few elements which still cling to the link with the Vatican. Necessary authorization will be granted by the People's Government, and the independent Church will be organized. It should be borne in mind that the break between the Catholic Church and the Vatican has no importance except for theologians. The masses are but tenuously linked with the Vatican in their religious practices.

"We now reach the final stage. Once the separation between the Church and the Vatican has become an accomplished fact, we can contrive things so that we select those to be consecrated Bishops. The people will be encouraged to practice their religion within the bosom of the New Church. (This phase of the struggle) must be conducted with tact and dexterity, and we shall gradually isolate the 'Old Guard' of the Vatican.

"It is notorious that when the practice of religion becomes simply a matter left to the individual's sense of responsibility, it is gradually forgotten. The rising generation will succeed the elder, and religion will become merely an episode of the past, important only as a topic to be considered in histories of the world Communist movement."

The Vatican has pointed out that this plan has been used several times in numerous countries. Cuba was the latest.

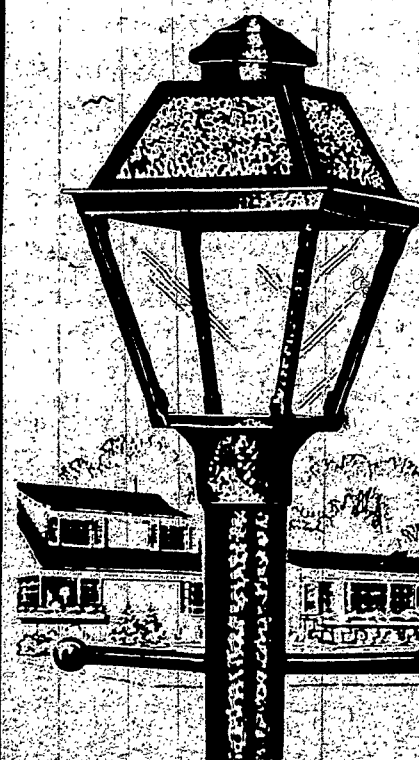

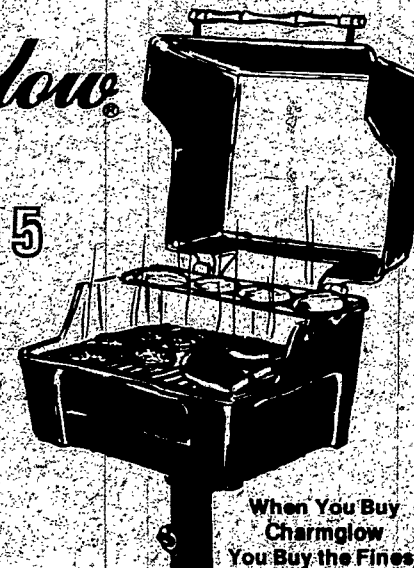
