### Our Prayer Room

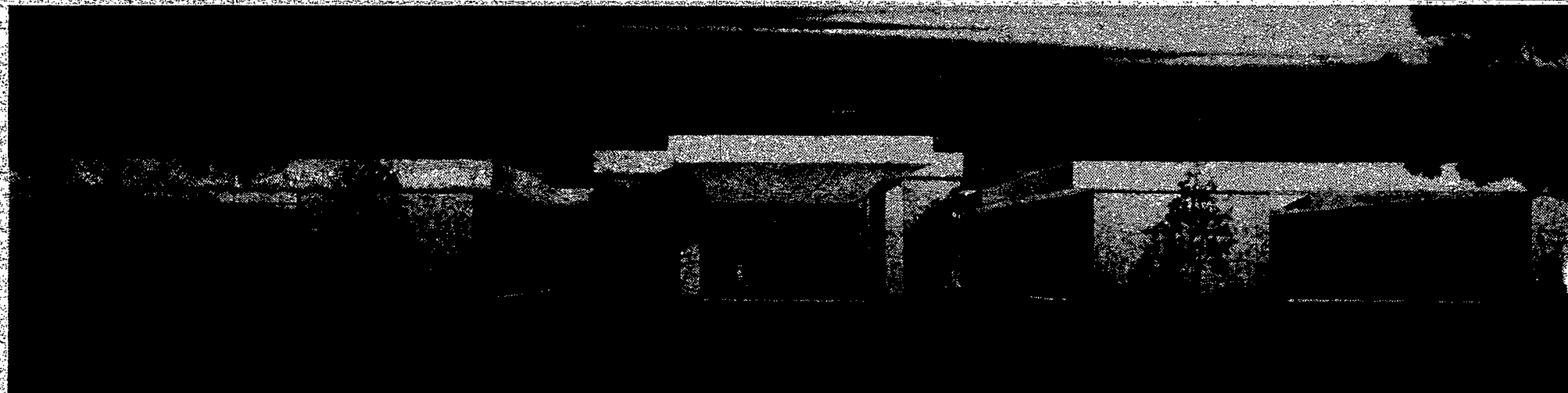
The patients and staff of the Monroe County Hospital had a contest to name the intimate new chapel and adjacent meeting room. The rooms were fondly christened "Our Prayer Room" and "Our Family Room" in May, and have welcomed hundreds of patients and staff who stop in at the always-open doors.

Father Ammering and Mr. Wunrow led the fund raising for the two rooms, which represent the combined effort of the hospital auxiliary, the administration, patients, staff, and families.

It's a place for private meditation and small group devotions," said Father Bruce F. Ammering, chaplain at the hospital with The Rev. Gerald B. Wunrow. The bright orange prayer room is a twin to the cheery family room which is used as a nice conducive place to speak with families when there's a crisis in their life.

The doors to the prayer room are left open to anyone in the hospital. It is used by all faiths for small services and the chaplains have celebrated several prayer services together.

"We plan to use it more for joint services," said Mr. Wunrow, "and we hope that area clergy will take advantage of the rooms when they visit friends here."
