Media Distribution

What used to be called "Media Distribution" in the Pastoral Office directory now is the Media Development Center The new title applies more precisely.

The center prints, folds, stuffs and mails for the administration and some related outside agencies. It circulates films and film strips prepared for religious education programs, and movies used in school social studies and health courses. It produces regular radio programs, and occasional radio: messages, and has done video tapes for classroom use, and some. TV


