Local Women Attend Leadership Conference

Sister Judith Heberle, RSM, Sister Jamesine Riley, SSJ, and Sister Elizabeth Anne LeValley, SSJ, recently attended the annual assembly of the Leadership Conference of Women Religious, a national organization of 670 leaders of religious congregations in the United States.

"The New Spirit of '76 — a Call to Interdependence" was the theme of the 5-day conference held in Boston. Ms. Irma Mazelis, Human Rights Officer of the United Nations, and Sister Gertrude Foley, a Sister of Charity from Pennsylvania, spoke on the world and the reality and quality of religious life today.

"Interdependence no longer needs to be argued, it can be assumed," Ms. Mazelis stated. "At the economic and social levels, interdependence is now the overarching framework within which foreign policy is being conducted. The implications need to be defined and elaborated."

Sister Gertrude Foley explained community as "the body acting around a central life project of value. It is interdependence that

requires order and healthy tension and structures of reconciliation; interdependence will lead to corporate communion." She challenged the delegates to be "women of these times, ready to listen to these times and bless them."

On Sept. 27 and 28 Sisters Judith Jamesine, Elizabeth Anne, and Rosalma Hayes will meet with New York State Bishops at the LCWR regional meeting in New York City.
