**Rerum Novarum** Encyclical, Pope Leo XIII. The most definitive of the many Church statements on social action, affirmed and reaffirmed by subsequent popes. 25 cents.

**Pascendi Dominici & Lamentabili** Encyclical, Pope Pius X. Lists the duties, obligations and errors of Catholics necessary for a basic understanding of Church positions and teachings. 50 cents.

**Social Reconstruction** Encyclical, Pope Pius XI. Reaffirms teachings with a stress on intimate harmony between "all good men." 25 cents.

**Christian Education of Youth** Encyclical, Pope Pius XI. Superb, timely. 25 cents.

**Atheistic Communism** Encyclical, Pope Pius XI. Church views on socialism and communism reaffirmed. Extremely important today. 25 cents.

**Function of the State** Encyclical, Pope Pius XII. Points to "signs of Paganism" vs the Family; moral law vs Pride. 25 cents.

Near the Chair of Peter, Pope John XXIII. One of my favorites by good Pope John. Speaks of knowledge through truth, religious indifference, harmony, nations, the

**Christianity and Social Progress** Encyclical, Pope John XXIII. "Separated from God, man becomes a monster to himself and others... those who profess Catholicism must take special care to be consistent, and not compromise in matters wherein the integrity of religion or morals will suffer harm... It is a monstrous masterpiece of this age that (science and technology) have transformed man, as it were, into a giant... yet in the order of the supernatural and eternal, (into) a pigmy." The "warning voice" of the Church. 25 cents.

**Peace on Earth** Encyclical, Pope John XXIII. A warning against public authority imposed by force. The state must not interfere with families. 25 cents.

**Lumen Gentium**, solemn promulgation, Pope Paul VI. A scholarly work which requires serious and concentrated study as it covers much ground. Ideal for a series of homilies or for classroom discussions. Masterful sections on the laity, the Religious, and the Blessed Virgin (Protectress of the United States, who has promised the conversion of Russia.) 50 cents.

**On the Development of Peoples** Pope Paul VI. Places political action in the proper perspective as seen officially by the Vatican. Speaks of liberalism, violence, pluralism, atheistic humanism and materialism. It speaks of the Church views on world hunger, wealth, careful dialogue, and of youth. 50 cents.

"It is a fundamental principle of social philosophy, fixed and unchangeable, that one should not withdraw from individuals and commit to the community that which they can accomplish by their own enterprise and industry." (The Principle of Subsidiarity as defined in Pope John's Christianity and Social Progress.)
