## Museum Features Early Maps

A map of the Great Lakes area drawn in 1670 by a Sulpician missionary is featured in Mapping the Genesee Country, a major new exhibit at the Rochester Museum and Science Center. It is one of 27 maps recounting the discovery, exploration, and settlement of western New York state by Europeans.

The exploration of Lake Ontario and the other Great Lakes was largely a product of French spiritual zeal and commercial enterprise. The French explorers were accompanied by missionaries, often Jesuits, who were scholars and kept detailed records.

In 1669, Sulpician Fathers Rene Galinee and Francois Dollier accompanied the celebrated LaSalle on an investigation of the Great River that led to the Western Ocean. The group landed at Irondequoit Bay, and was escorted to a large Seneca village in the vicinity of present-day Victor. Detained there for a month by Iroquois jealously guarding their powerful control of the fur trade, the expedition was prevented from traveling farther west, but proved successful on other fronts. Galinee produced a map of the Irondequoit Bay area that stimulated further French exploration of the Great Lakes region. On it, he told future explorers about the land near Bistol Center, the four Seneca villages in the area, the many cattfish in the Genesee River near the falls and the numerous "small lakes" along the bay.

The exhibit will run through next May.

## Dunn Towers Dedicated

Dunn Towers in Gates, an apartment house for retired people, was dedicated Saturday noon, a year after its opening.

Bishop Dennis W. Hickey offered a blessing and the Rev. Donald Boyd, pastor of Gates Wesleyan Church, gave the dedication prayer in the presence of numerous public servants, clergy and members of the community at large. Mrs. Grace Baker, town historian, was among the speakers. Refreshments were served by 17 hostesses from the neighborhood at an open house after the ceremonies.

Dunn Towers stands behind St. Theodore's Church on property formerly owned by the Spencerport Road parish. It was named for the pastor, Father Gerald E. Dunn, who was an active promoter of the state-funded project and is president of the board of directors.
