Workshop Based On Parish Survey

An opinion survey taken among parishioners of St. Vincent de Paul, Churchville, provided guidelines for a recent parish council workshop at the Ramada Inn. On the basis of parishioners' comments on various aspects of church and community life, goals and objectives were defined in small group sessions, and

priorities set by the entire assembly.

The day opened with a prayer service and brief reviews of group process and the theology of mission in a parish. It closed with Mass celebrated by Father Louis J. Hohman, pastor.

ABC Sets Outreach on Food Stamps

Action for a Better Community has announced a new Food Stamp Outreach Program to serve low-income residents in the counties of Monroe, Orleans, and Wayne.

Funded by the Community Services Administration through an agreement with the State Department of Social Services, this program will strengthen ABC's Cluster Nutrition Program which is studying areas of malnutrition and hunger in the three-county area, to find reasons why people are hungry and to find ways to correct this situation.

One of the areas most frequently referred to as a problem is the Food Stamp Program and its inaccessibility to those in need. This was most especially noticed among lower income senior citizens. This group of people face multiple problems; they are on a fixed income, they have transportation problems getting to the Monroe County Department of Social Service office on Westfall Road and wait in the long lines in order to apply for food stamps, and they have difficulty in reading and understanding the application forms. They also do not understand that by purchasing food stamps they will be able to expand their purchasing power within their fixed income. This program will try to minimize the stigma that older persons, especially, relate to using food stamps, which in many peoples' minds means accepting welfare.

The Sacrament of Anointing will be celebrated at St. Thomas the Apostle Church on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 25 at 11 a.m. The sacrament is offered primarily for those persons who have a serious illness and for those whose age makes them more susceptible to serious illness, and also for the elderly.
