Highland Nursing School To Affiliate With Nazareth

The School of Nursing of Highland Hospital will phase out its 85-year-old diploma program beginning next year and affiliate with Nazareth College in the first upper division baccalaureate program for nurses in the Rochester area, according to an announcement by John B. Stevens, executive director of the hospital.

Stevens announced the decision of the hospital's board of trustees "to make available all appropriate resources of the School of Nursing to Nazareth College during the next three years." Those resources will include "clinical facilities, classroom space, library materials and other assistance needed to fulfill our role as the primary clinical resource for the new program."

The arrangement "will provide students with a continuum of clinical experience and allow the Nazareth faculty to work more closely with members of the hospital health teams and health care delivery system," he said.

No new freshmen will be admitted to the Highland School of Nursing after this fall, Stevens said. In September 1977, Nazareth will enroll its first class in the new nursing program.

In July of this year, Sister Marion Hoctor, vice president for academic affairs at Nazareth, announced approval of the program by the State Board of Regents and confirmed the college's intention to re-establish its Department of Nursing.

She said that more than 400 inquiries concerning the two-year program for college juniors and

seniors have already been received. The program leads to a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Nursing and is open to all registered nurses who are graduates of accredited two and three year nursing programs. Nurses who have been working for a number of years as well as recent graduates are eligible to apply.

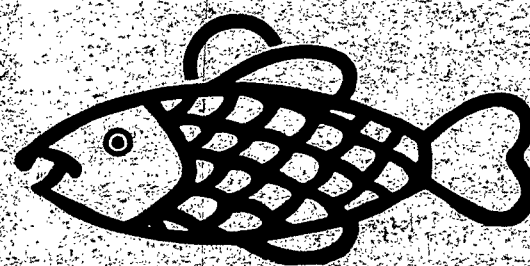
