1977 Ecumenical Calendars Are Ready

Hornell — Hornell Ecumenical Ministries (HEM) has announced the sale of their 1977 ecumenical calendar. The colorful, wall style calendar contains more than 850 Scriptural, Denominational and civic entries. The calendar is artistically attractive for both business and home display, and useful for personal annotations.

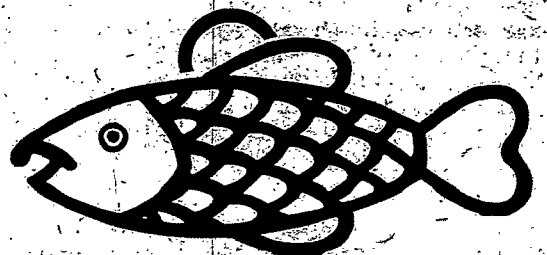
