Father Londero is able to purchase building materials at wholesale prices and he passes the savings along to the families. In addition, the homes are of a new

design, wooden, American style, and Father Londero helps each family in building the houses. In addition, according to Father Beatini, neighbors also help in the

"Again," Father Beatini em-phasized, "I can't say enough good about the Catholic Relief Services."
