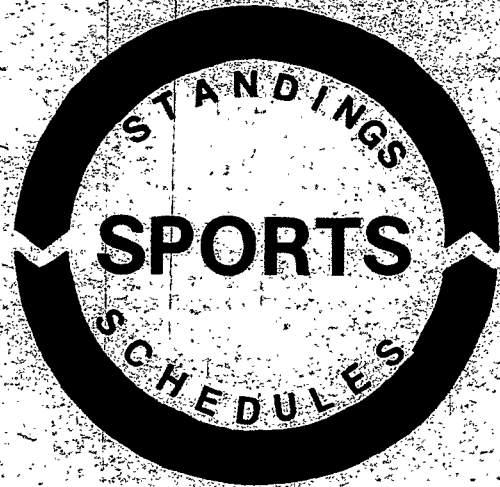

## Young Leaders on the Move

"It is time for a new generation of leadership to cope with new problems and new opportunities," so declared the late President John F. Kennedy. And there is a new generation of leaders emerging from our high schools.

There are many programs through which potential leaders are discovered; two of which are the Century III Leadership Scholarship competition, administered by the National Association of Secondary School Principals, and the Hugh O'Brien Youth Foundation. Recently, some of the local winners in these programs were announced and included BK's Cynthia Anastas, Nazareth's Lori Sailer, and Cardinal Mooney student, Stella Haag. The girls, all seniors, received the nomination for the Century III state competitions.

BK's Diane Finnegan was nominated to represent her school in the Hugh O'Brien Youth Foundation state competition. She was selected by a group of teachers and advisers who looked for a sophomore with outstanding leadership and service qualities. After her qualifications are submitted to a state group they will then be judged by a committee of 51 nationally recognized men and women. One boy and girl from each state will be chosen to attend the annual leadership seminar which will be held in Chicago in April.

Those selected for the Century III Scholarship Program were judged on their leadership potential, with emphasis on community and extracurricular activities, high scores on current event exams and on their written viewpoints about America's needs and challenges for the future.

They will compete with other high school winners from around the state and have an opportunity for the \$10,000 national scholarship. State winners will receive an all-expense trip to the national meeting in Williamsburg, Va., to participate in seminars on current issues.

These young students have more than their leadership attributes in common; they are busy members of society.

Mooney's Stella, along with her

duties as vice-president of the school's French Club is an active member of the National Organization of Women and the Salvation Army Women's Auxiliary where she helps organize relief programs.

She will attend the Indiana Institute of Technology for studies in nuclear technology. Realizing the necessity of finding alternative energy sources, her career goal is to be instrumental in scaling down nuclear generators for home and business use.

In her thesis about America's entering its third century and the problems it will face, she stressed the dilemma of overpopulation. One solution she advocated was the need for mass education. "Make people aware that there is a population explosion."

All these young leaders are aware of the world's problems and because of this awareness they take their responsibilities seriously and hope through their conscientiousness to aid in finding solutions to these problems.
