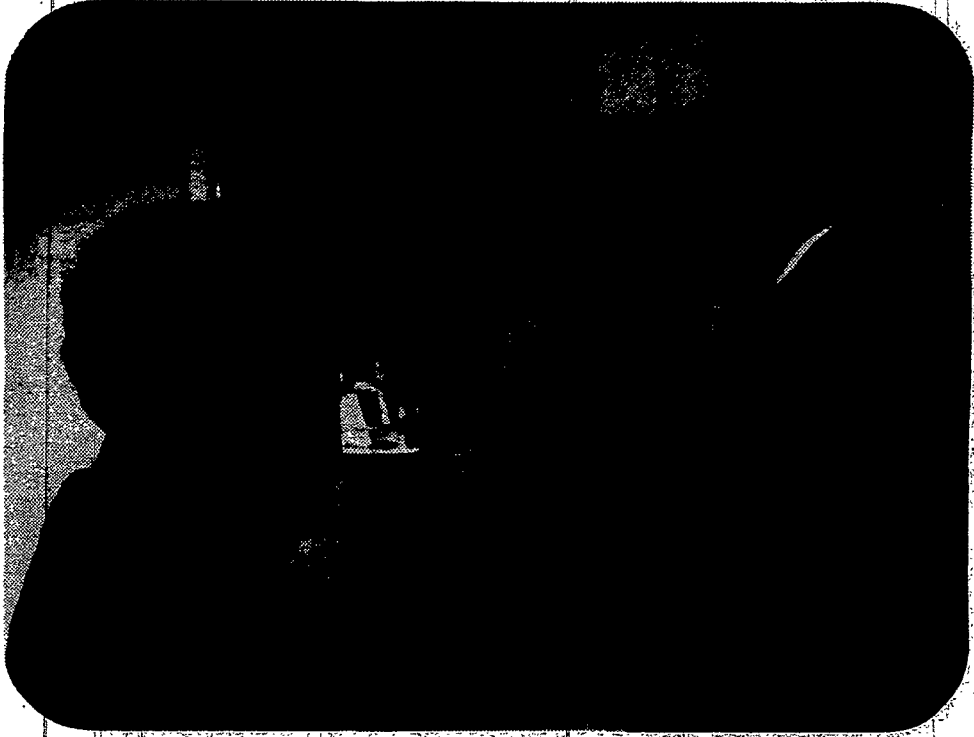

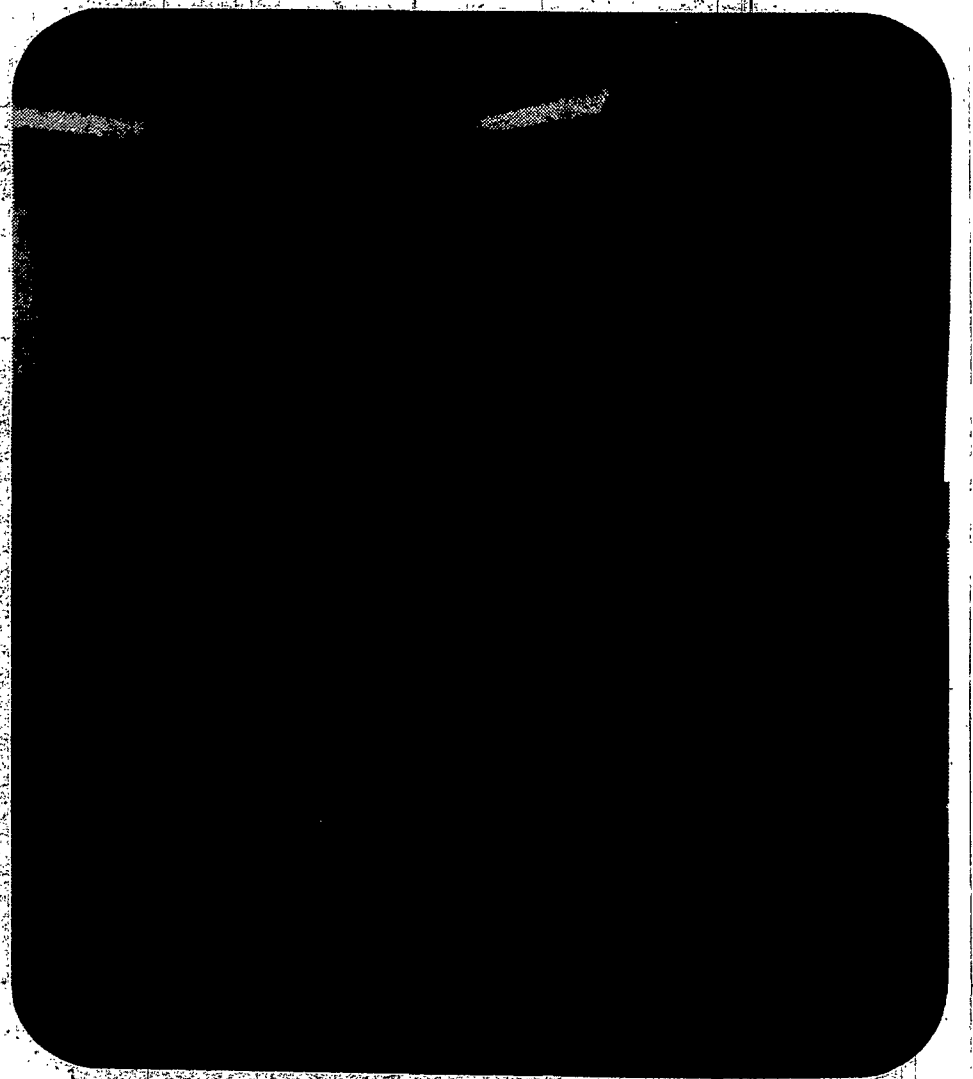


The director shows the bishop his bulletin board of clippings and photographs. He says he has had "a good press."
