In the Letters to the Editor of Jan. 5, Mrs. Judith B. Echaniz took me to task for speaking of the Church's teaching on the indissolubility of marriage as "a terrible oversimplification."

Very obviously Mrs. Echaniz misunderstood my statement about oversimplification because I was not questioning the words of Jesus but rather questioning the assumption that every time two people stand before a priest and pronounce their vows it is necessarily a sacramental marriage.

The Church has come to realize that in marriages even before a priest and two witnesses (the necessary form in the Catholic Church) sometimes the couples by reason of immaturity are placing a block on the grace they would receive in the sacrament.

all exists, to say nothing of a sacramental marriage. Mrs. Echaniz doesn't have to take my word for this. I refer her to the Diocesan Tribunals which declare null and void from the beginning marriages performed even by a priest in which one or both parties lacked the capability of making a mature commitment.

The last paragraph of Mrs. Echaniz's letter is a very beautiful one. When two people are married in that understanding, at least in embryonic form, then it is indeed a sacramental marriage and one that is for life.

I am very glad that Mrs. Echaniz wrote this letter because it points up the great responsibility that we priests have to prepare young people to be open to a sacramental marriage and that terrible responsibility of parents to bring their young people to understand that when they are married in the Church it has a very special meaning over and above, merely being legally bound together.
