Do the names St. Claire, Friars, Golden Gate, Soul. Kings, Golden Harp, and St. Perhaps you've heard them mentioned. To a beer can connoisseur these are the names of rare, obsolete. collectable beer cans.

Beer can collecting is one of America's fastest growing hobbys. The Beer Can Collectors of America (BCCA) is a club that was
formed seven years ago to ormed seven years ago to
unite beer can enthusiasts The club now boasts a membership of over lo,000 collectors. The association distributes a bimonthly newsletter; a monthly iwant ad letter, and holds an annual "canvention."

Collections range in rank from "brewery worker" with up to 249 cans, to "grand brewmaster," (1000 or more). Most collectors save empty cans of all sizes, preferably opened from the bottom
with a can opener. This with a can opener. This

collectors. The BCCA prohibits the buying and selling of beer cans at their meetings and uses trading as
the method of exchange. the method of exchange. open to everyone and to those with a timited income
