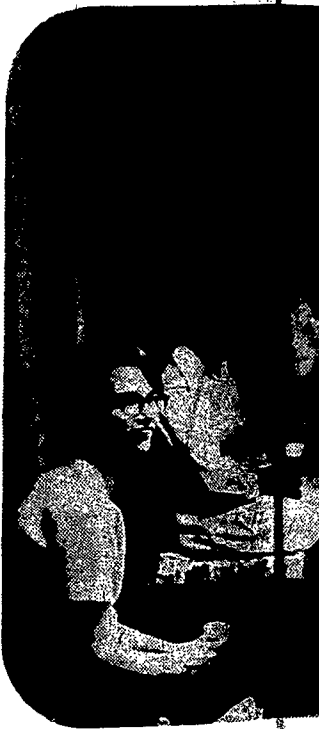
At 'Good Sam' Hospital
