Since they've been together they have performed for activities at Our

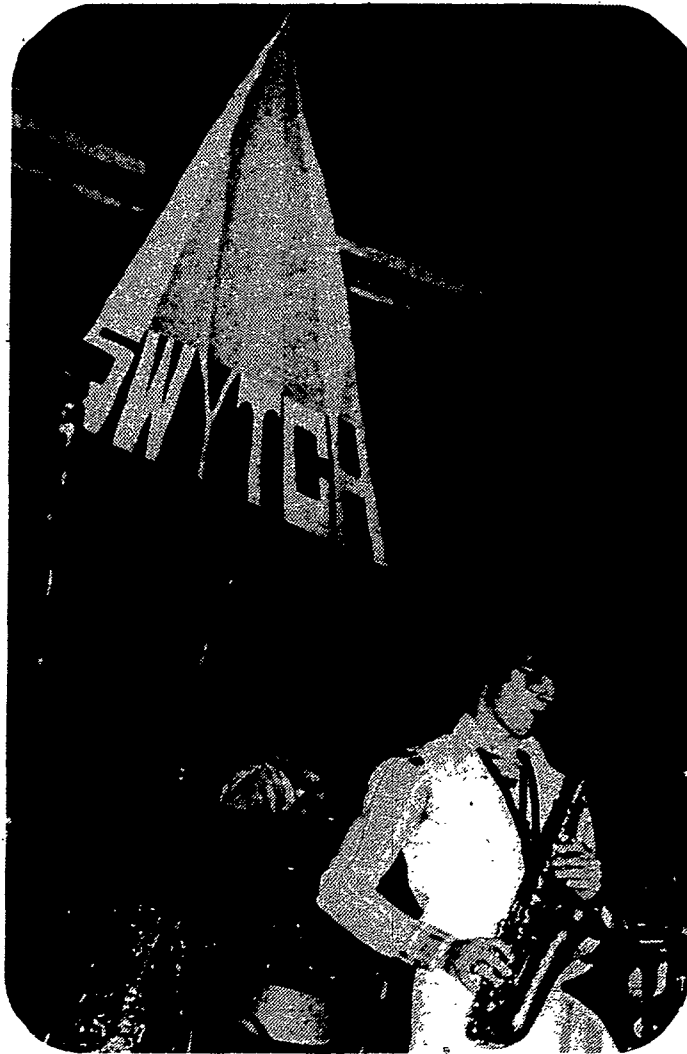
