



Planned Parenthood's new booklet 11 Million Teenagers: What Can Be Done About the Epidemic of Adolescent Pregnancies in the U.S.



And it is not exactly news either that the booklet is crammed full of statistics pointing to the dangers facing 4 million "sexually active" teenagers...a million abortions a year...600,000 unwanted babies a year ... mortality and morbidity rates...toxemia anemia, low birth weight rates etc...all of which, according to Planned Parenthood and Daniel Callahan support NOT the need for improved discipline and moral training in the home, but the need for more easily obtainable contraceptive pills and IUDs for teenagers, and the "need" for increased Federal funds, already almost \$200,000,000 a year.

# K of C Gift

New Haven, Conn. - The Knights of Columbus have awarded \$10,000 to the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops to support the organizations's pro-life activities, it was announced by Supreme Knight Virgil C. Dechant.

The check for the pro life effort was presented to Bishop G. Emmet Carter of London, Ont. president of the Canadian bishops' conference, through the offices of Deputy Suprem Knight Ernest J. Wolff of Peterborough, Ont.

Bishop Carter called the gift a "most generous contribution" and stated that the Canadian bishops "deeply appreciate the show of concern and cooperation of the Knights of Columbus."
