Everybody knows, I'm sure, that Planned Parenthood is a non-profit organization funded by the Community Chest, the Ford Foundation, the Rockefeller Foundation, the Kellogg Foundation, the Andrew Mellon Foundation, the Rockefeller Brothers Fund, John D. Rockefeller 3rd, Ortho Pharmaceutical Company, Ortho Diagnostics Inc, the United States Department of Health Education and Welfare, and many private donors. (All information can be verified through financial reports.)

We know too that the late Dr. Alan Guttmacher, until his death in 1974, was president of the organization. A dedicated gentleman, Dr. Guttmacher was an early signer of the Humanist Manifesto. Another signer of the Humanist Manifesto, Issac Asimov, serves on the PP Board of Directors. Dr. Sol Gordon of Syracuse University is the author of Sex-Comix in which he recommends Planned Parenthood abortion clinics; the comic books, in turn, are distributed by Planned Parenthood in many cities across the nation. Sol Gordon is a signer of the Humanist Manifesto.

And it comes as no surprise that Planned Parenthood, in its drive to prevent further "unwanted" babies (they estimate that over one million a year are born to women unable to secure abortions, despite liberal abortion laws) has received at least partial support from well-known Catholics, including Senator Edward F. Kennedy, Supreme Court Justice William J. Brennan Jr, Congressman/Priest Robert J. Drinan SJ, Lt. Governor Marianne Krupak and Mr. Daniel Callahan, a "leading Catholic spokesman". In

Jaded by this media assault on my ears and my nerves I should probably give up the tube for a while. Since I probably won't or can't, the next best thing is to limit myself to Captain Kangaroo for the next week or so to try and regain a little perspective.

As one who believes in the educational properties of television wholeheartedly I am continually finding new subjects which would make splendid classroom projects for us average viewers. An introduction to what's under the hood of the automobile?

Planned Parenthood's new booklet 11 Million Teenagers: What Can Be Done About the Epidemic of Adolescent Pregnancies in the U.S.

Callahan wrote, "Teenage pregnancy can, through better education and preventative services, be, if not altogether avoided, at least reduced, through better maternity, abortion and social services..." (Callahan neatly suggests that the only alternative is to ignore the teenagers totally.) And it is not exactly news either that the booklet is crammed full of statistics pointing to the dangers facing 4 million "sexually active" teenagers...a million abortions a year...600,000 unwanted babies a year...mortality and morbidity rates...toxemia, anemia, low birth weight rates etc...all of which, according to Planned Parenthood and Daniel Callahan support NOT the need for improved discipline and moral training in the home, but the need for more easily obtainable contraceptive pills and IUDs for teenagers, and the "need" for increased Federal funds, already almost \$200,000,000 a year.

Well nothing new yet. But, is there something beyond family planning?

K of C Gift

New Haven, Conn. — The Knights of Columbus have awarded \$10,000 to the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops to support the organizations' pro-life activities, it was announced by Supreme Knight Virgil C. Dechant.

The check for the pro life effort was presented to Bishop G. Emmet Carter of London, Ont. president of the Canadian bishops' conference, through the offices of Deputy Supreme Knight Ernest J. Wolff of Peterborough, Ont.
