Keynote speakers on these Congress days are Rev. John Gallen, S.J., liturgist, and Dr. Maria Harris, catechist.

Special participants during all three Congress days will be The Dameans, entertaining throughout the days, providing music for Saturday's liturgy, and 'in concert' on Friday evening at 8 P.M.

By returning the registration form with check, you are registered for the Congress. Pick up Congress materials at the registration desk on Friday or Saturday, June 3 or 4.

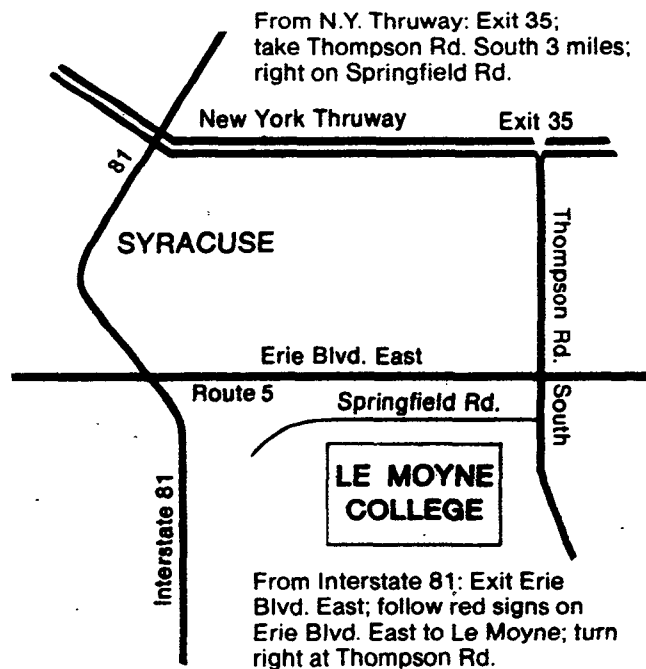
