Religious Education Days Set

The annual Religious Education Days for parish staff members will be June 6 in Elmira and June 7 in Rochester. Dr. Maria Harris, writer and teacher in the field at parish, diocesan and university levels, will be the keynote speaker.

The Elmira program will be conducted at the Holiday Inn, in the afternoon, and at Notre Dame High School, in the evening. Meeting places in Rochester are the Airport Sheraton and Mercy High School. Several publishers will display pertinent materials. Those planning to attend should register in advance with their parish religious education coordinators, according to an announcement issued by the diocesan Department of Religious Education.

Kidera Hails Bishop At Baccalaureate

The traditional quality of the baccalaureate service, its firmly held place in American college graduations, was pointed out by Dr. Robert Kidera as he made his first Nazareth College commencement appearance in the role of president.

"Each year," he said, "just prior to receiving their degrees, the candidates assemble in formal ceremony to acknowledge their belief in God..."

Addressing the class of 1977 - 260 men and women of varied religious backgrounds - he pointed out also a 53-year-old Nazareth College tradition, "that is, a special, warm relationship with the Roman Catholic Bishop of Rochester."

He presented Bishop Joseph L. Hogan at the baccalaureate service May 14, saying that he welcomed the opportunity to express to him "publicly and officially, our sincere admiration for his courage, his openness and his enlightened leadership during a period of transition and uncertainty."

The bishop, he said, is "a gentle man, a humble man and a compassionate man."

"He has inspired us all with his courage, his willingness to speak out for the dignity of the human person, both male and female; for exercising his episcopal authority with an openness, a willingness to listen and to explain; for his fortitude when his leadership in the cause of

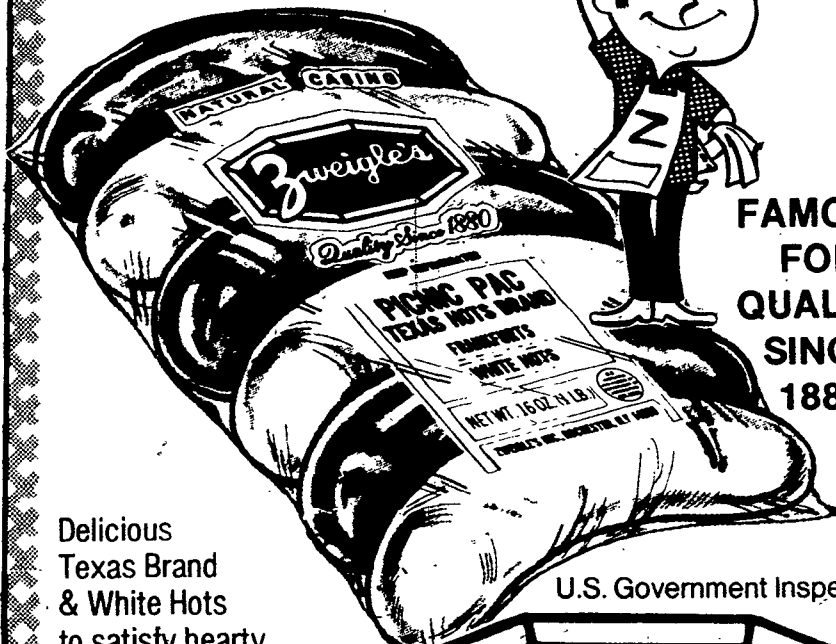
