

### China Continues Testing

Communist China released this photo of a successful hydrogen bomb test July 27, shortly after Vice Premier Li Hsien-Nien told visiting Japanese that China would continue nuclear weapons development. Date of the test or location was not disclosed. Japanese experts said it apparently took place after Chinese Communist Party Chairman Hua Kuo-feng consolidated his power in October 1976. (RNS)

## Back Food Stamps Due

A recent court ruling may make some households eligible for food stamp benefits retroactive to Aug. 4, 1974, according to the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

A Federal Appeals Court in San Francisco has denied a USDA appeal of a 1975 U.S. District Court decision ordering the agency to disregard housing subsidies from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban

Development when determining eligibility for food stamp allotments.

Food stamp agencies have been abiding by the lower court decision since Feb. 27, 1976, when the USDA initiated its appeal, but have been using Oct. 8, 1975 — the date of the original ruling — as the cutoff date for retroactive benefits. The recent court action ordered the USDA to set the cutoff date at Aug. 5, 1974, when the challenged

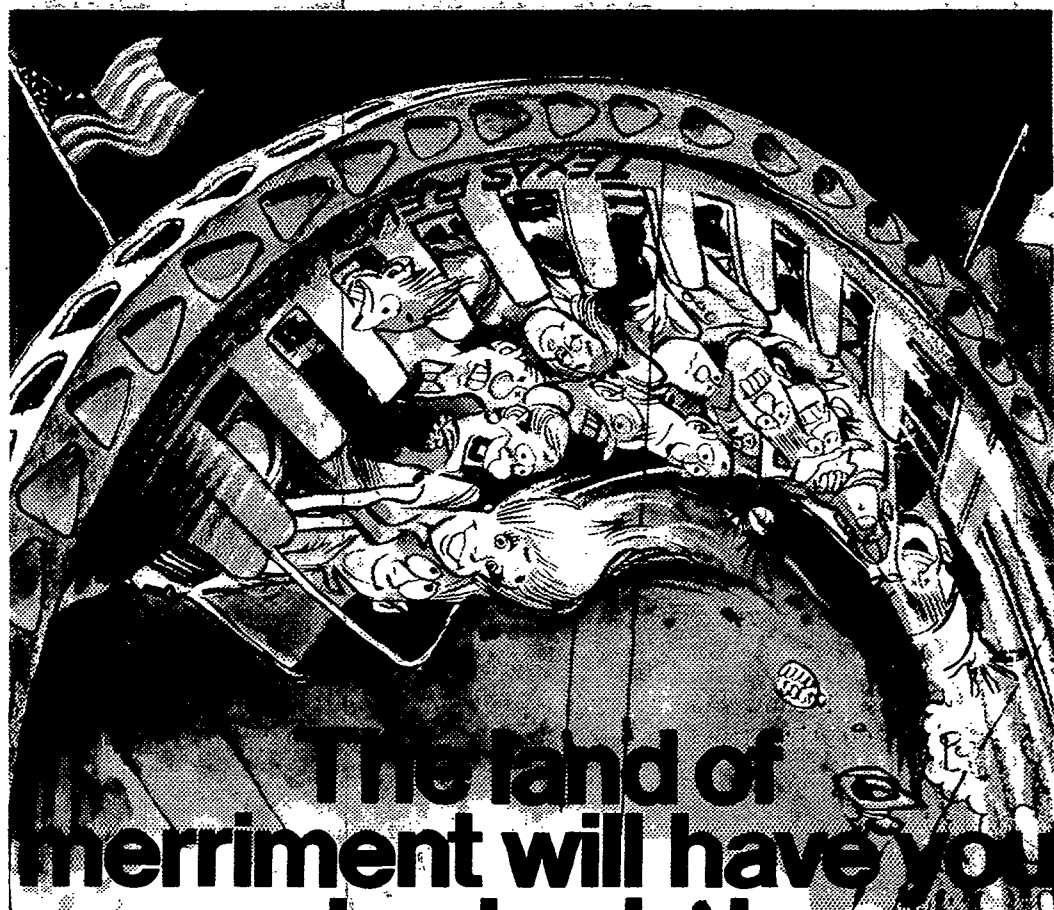
USDA directive which included HUD payments as income first went into effect.

Households whose food stamp benefits were denied or reduced as a result of the USDA policy may be eligible for retroactive benefits, even though they currently may not be using food stamps. Persons who think they might be affected should contact their local food stamp offices.
