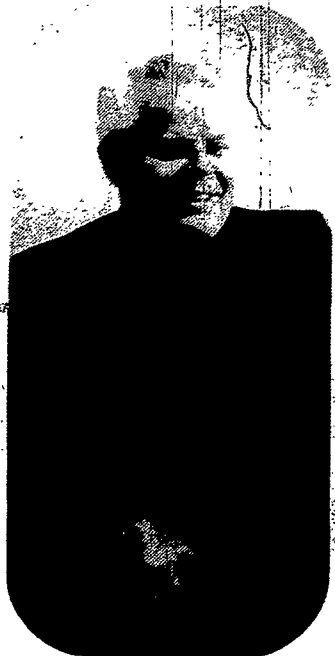


# Aquinas Welcomes New Principal

Father Menner took over duties as principal of Aquinas Institute on July 1 and has been preparing the school for the new term which will begin on Sept. 7. He is no stranger to Aq as he taught Math at the school in 1956 and again from 1965-70.

"They know what I'm like," he quipped, "they've heard about me from their older brothers."

Though according to Father, his forte is teaching he is ready to face the

## Bike Safety Rules

Better than 60 million Americans will be going back to school this fall from kindergarten to graduate school. Many of them will be bicycling back to school and here are some recommended bicycle safety driving rules of the road from the Bicycle Manufacturers Association

- 1). Obey all applicable safety regulations, signs, signals and markings.
- 2). Observe all local ordinances pertaining to bicycle operation.
- 3). Keep right, drive with the traffic, not against it. Drive single file.
- 4). Watch out for drain grates, soft shoulders and other road surface hazards.
- 5). Watch out for car doors opening, or for cars pulling out into traffic.
- 6). Don't carry passengers or packages that interfere with your vision or control.
- 7). Never hitch a ride on a truck or other vehicle.
- 8). Be extremely careful at all intersections, particularly when making a left turn.
- 9). Use hand signals to indicate turning or stopping.
- 10). Protect yourself at night with the required reflectors and lights
- 11). Drive a safe bike. Have it inspected to ensure good mechanical condition.
- 12). Drive your bike defensively; watch out for the other guy.
