
Bishop Hogan will also ordain John Opoku-Aquah of St. Michael's, Jamasi, Ashanti, Ghana (West Africa), the son of Mr. John K. Adu and Madam Joana A. Nyame of Ghana (West Africa), to the Diaconate. He is presently a graduate student at St. Bernard's and will be returning to his own diocese of Ghana following ordination and the completion of his studies.

As deacons, they will draw new strength from the gift of the Holy Spirit and will provide help for the Bishop. When appointed ministers of the Liturgy they will proclaim the gospel, be custodian and distributor of the Eucharist. In addition, it will be their duty to instruct the faithful, to preside at public prayer, to confer baptism, to assist at marriages, to bring Eucharist to the dying and. to lead the rites of burial. Consecrated by the laying on of hands that comes from the apostles, and linked more closely to the altar, they will undertake the ministry of charity in the name of the Bishop or the parish priest. The seven candidates will also commit themselves to a life of celibacy, to the daily prayer of the Liturgy of the Hours, and to the promise of obedience to the Bishop of their individual diocese.



Columbus Re-Lands!


