Catholic Status in Vietnam

Vatican City (RNS) — Roman Catholic Archbishop Paul Nguyen Van Binh of Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon) said here that Vietnamese Catholics were determined to coexist with the country's Communist regime.

The regime in Vietnam, he said, was seeking "to unite all citizens in an effort to rebuild the country" and that, consequently, "The Catholics of Vietnam refuse to live in a 'ghetto' and to remain on the margin of society."

The archbishop spoke at a session of the fifth world Synod of Bishops, which opened here Sept. 30, for month-long discussions on "Catechetics," or religious

Worship Freedom Urged

Belgrade, Yugoslavia (RNS) — The representative of Vatican City State, in a speech here criticizing religious restrictions in Communist countries, appealed for freedom of worship for Eastern Rite Catholics in the Soviet Union.

Msgr. Achille Silvestrini, undersecretary of the Vatican's Council for the Public Affairs of the Church, spoke at a session of the 35-nation conference, which opened here Oct. 4 to review progress on human rights, European security and economic cooperation.

The Belgrade parley was set up to check on compliance with accords signed in Helsinki, Finland, on Aug. 1, 1975, at the conclusion of the Conference on European Security and Cooperation. The accords cover recognition of post-World War II boundaries, military affairs, the free movement of people and information across borders, and other human rights, including freedom of conscience and religion.

Msgr. Silvestrini deplored "difficulties thrown in the way of religious practice for certain categories of persons and to religious education."

He said, "Appeals, testimonies, and requests continue to multiply, sometimes impassioned and anguished because the situation in some regions is still far from a normal life of sufficient liberty."

Without mentioning by name, Msgr. Silvestrini called for freedom of Eastern Rite Catholics in the USSR. They are located in the Soviet Ukraine. The Vatican official referred to "a grave wound which we would like to see remedied and healed with a hope that we cannot abandon."

In 1946, the Ukrainian Catholic Church was forcibly incorporated into the Ukrainian Orthodox Church, a branch of the Russian Orthodox Church.

A year earlier, the archbishop of Lwow for Ukrainian Catholics, Joseph Slipyi, was imprisoned for unspecified crimes. Released after 18 years in Soviet prisons, he was allowed to go to Rome in February 1963 and was named major archbishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Church by Pope Paul. He was made a cardinal in 1965.

instruction, especially for children and youth. The current assembly of the Synod, an advisory body of the Church set up after Vatican II, is being attended by 204 prelates, mostly bishops, from all over the world.

The Vietnamese archbishop told his catechists that preists and catechists in Vietnam must find a way to present the Christian message in a "new language" which will be understood by congregations steeped in Communist concepts.

He added that Vietnamese Christians had to present "a new face, the authentic face of Christ and of the Church," because, he said, the Church was being accused of having been "in collusion with imperialism" in the past.

A decision to "help construct society" was made by Vietnamese

Catholic bishops at meetings held in Hue in July 1976. Archbishop Binh said, "We feel that in doing so we did not stage a revolution but followed the concepts of Vatican Council II."

Insisting that the Church in Vietnam will not "hide" the differences between Marxism and Christianity, Archbishop Binh asked: "Does St. Paul's position — to be Jew with the Jews and Greek with the Greeks — apply to Christians living in a Marxist environment?"
