Slander Charged

Editor:

In the name of all the other theology teachers in the diocese, and par-ticularly those at McQuaid Jesuit High School, I would like a retraction or an apology for Father Paul Cuddy's slanderous remarks in the Courier-Journal 10-12-

Slander is a false report which injures the reputation of another, and Father Cuddy's column was slanderous.

He tells of meeting two boys, one black and one white The black boy, who went to St Monica's, still practices his religion. The white boy, who went to Blessed Sacrament and McQuaid, no longer practices · Father Cuddy concludes, "Looks like the Jesuits didn't do you much good "He does not burden us with the name of the black boy's high school Could it also have been McQuaid?

Later Father Cuddy says, "I should hesitate to fault the Jesuits for the lacunas and twists in my friend's understanding, or lack of it " And he has already said, "Looks like the Jesuits didn't do you much good." Father Cuddy is right, he should have hesitated The trouble is he didn't.






