Deaths

Two St. Joseph Nuns Die on the Same Day

Two members of the St. Joseph congregation died Oct. 29, 1977— Sister Miriam Joseph Kennedy, at the age of 87, and Sister Joanna Schoenherr, 84. Their years of service to the schools of the diocese add up to nearly a century.

Sister Miriam entered the convent from St. Mary's parish in Dansville in 1922 and taught at St. Mary's, Elmira, for 24 years. After that, she was principal and superior at St. Bridget's for six years and at St. Patrick's, Corning, for another six-year term. Her last assignment before her retirement in 1969 was at Holy Apostles.

Mercy Sister Agnes Miriam is her blood sister and sole survivor apart from nieces and nephews.

The Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated in the Motherhouse chapel by Father Joseph Reinhart. Monsignors Emmett Murphy and John M. Duffy assisted and Fathers Frederick Walz and John Mulligan were present. Msgr. Murphy gave the homily.

Sister Joanna, from Our Lady of Perpetual Help parish, was a St. Joseph sister for 64 years and an elementary school teacher for 53. She served as principal at St. Bridget's for three years and at St. Patrick's, Dansville, for six. She taught at the old St. Patrick's Cathedral school for 14 years, then at St. Francis Xavier, St. Stanislaus, Holy Apostles, Sacred Heart Cathedral, St. Mary's Boys' Orphanage, St. Mary's, Canandaigua and St. Mary's in Dansville. She retired in 1967, from St. John's, Greece.

Two brothers survive her — Clement Schoenherr of Roswell, N.M., and Edwin Schoenherr of Philadelphia, Pa. There are also many nieces and nephews.

Sister Joanna's Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated by Benedictine Father James Kelly of Mt. Saviour Monastery. He was assisted, in the Motherhouse chapel, by Fathers Benedict Ehmann and Joseph Reinhart. Msgr. William Naughton was present.

Mary F. Greene Caufield of Avon, a member of many Catholic women's groups, died Oct. 30, 1977. The Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated last Wednesday in St. Monica's Church.

Association, Catholic Womens Club and School of the Holy Childhood association.

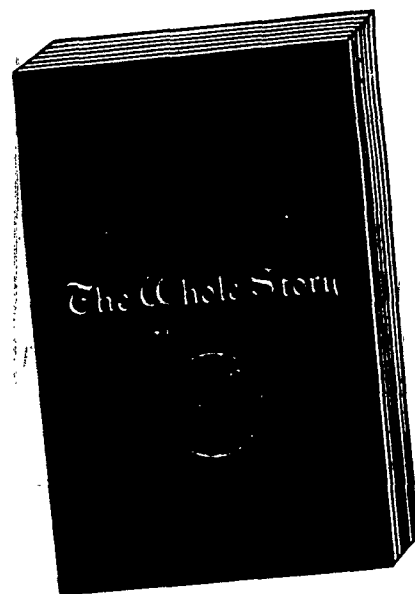
