# Newman's 'University' **Opens Kearney Series**

A liberal education, Dr. James Cameron says, turns out "ladies and gentlemen." And those words have fallen victim to the "inverted snobbery" of the modern world

Before we go further into this series on Natural Family Planning, I will take the time to urge you to read the powerful and deeply personal little book, First Do No Harm, by Natalee Greenfield, I'll write more on this book later. In my judgement, it should be recommended reading for every Catholic high school student in place of the guestionable books and authors now recommended in the diocesan text on human sexuality, Education In Love. -

I have yet to hear an acceptable reason for educators and politicians to continue to ignore Natural Family Planning. It is I believe a violation of moral and ethical principles (a sin of omission perhaps) to stress only the gadgets and methods which are profitable to such industrial giants as the Ortho Pharmaceutical Company, and which are so degrading and expensive, so dangerous and sometimes fatal to the misinformed Also it is wise to keep in mind the growing power of educators and politicians over the family. Once the tools of fertility control and moral education are removed from the family and put into the hands of the government, these tools can be used not only to force population control but secular humanism as well. Such measures as fertility control agents in drinking water supplies have already been proposed in the U.S. The U.N Fund for Population Activities has discussed for two years the implementation of compulsory family control

NFP should be but is not taught in every Catholic high school, Pre-Cana course and adult education class. It should not be taught by Planned Parenthood which claims to teach the natural methods, but bases its statements in faulty incomplete information NFP is best taught on a couple-tocouple basis, by families already using it themselves, and who are thoroughly trained in the latest teaching methods. Dr. Cameron was Rochester recently to speak on that text in the first of the Bishop James E. Kearney Lecture Series at St. John Fisher College.

Newman's university, Dr. Cameron said, is, among other things, "a place for the study and exercise of the imagination," "a lifeline to the human past," and "an intellectual power ... likely to be obnoxious to the national state."

Newman proposed that a "liberal arts" education is founded on the premise that "knowledge is capable of being its own end ... of being its own reward," Dr. Cameron noted.

The Bishop Kearney lectures were founded by an anonymous friend's gift to the college. The donor expressed his hope that three of the late bishop's favorite authors — Cardinal Newman, G.K. Chesterton and William Shakespeare would be the subjects of the lectures. For many years, Bishop Kearney was the national chaplain of the Newman Club Association. Father Charles Lavery, CSB, president of the college, described the series as "a living tribute to the late Bishop Kearney

John Henry Newman was one of the greatest of the 19th century thinkers. A noted scholar at Oxford and a preacher of the Church of England, Newman con-verted to Roman Catholic and in 1846, was ordained a priest. He was titled a Cardinal in 1879.


