Book Fair

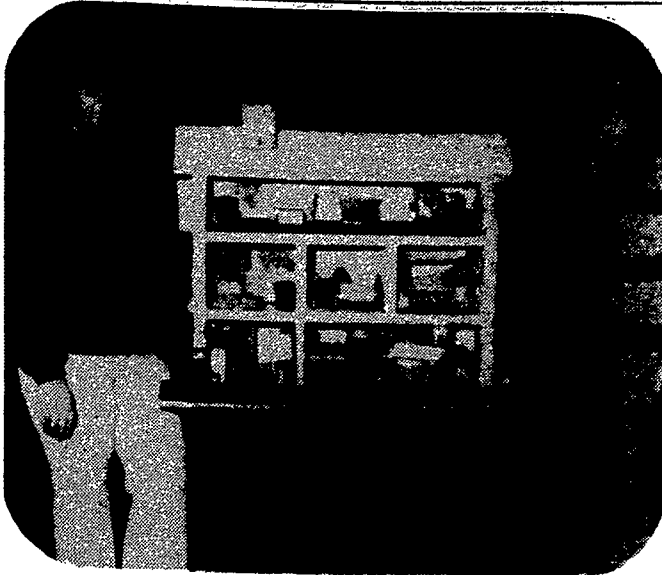

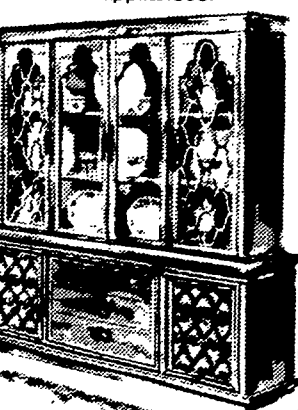
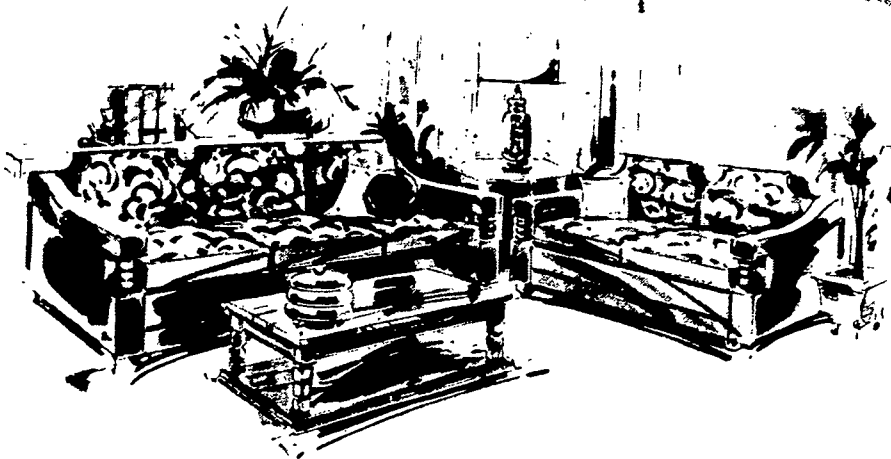
