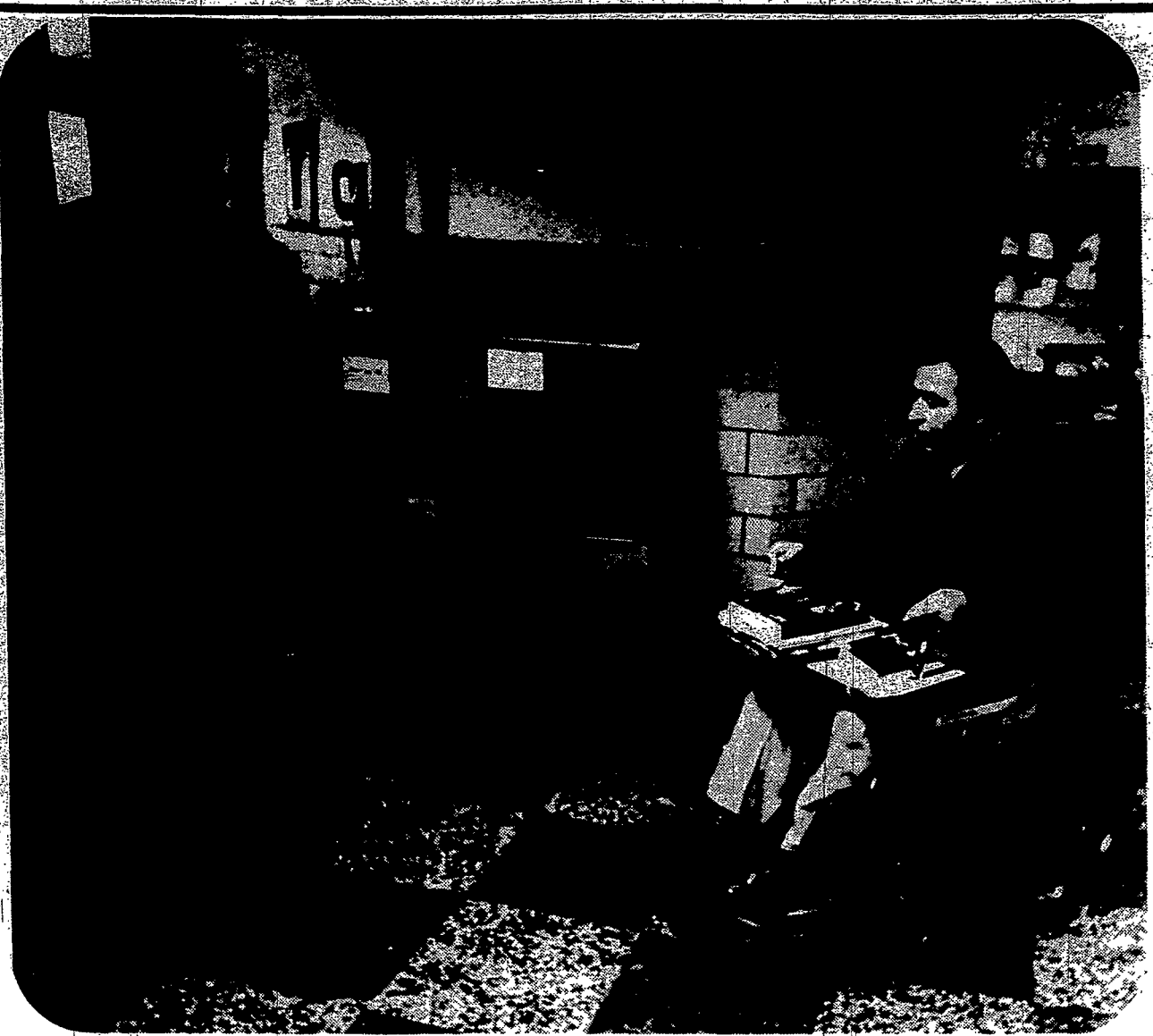
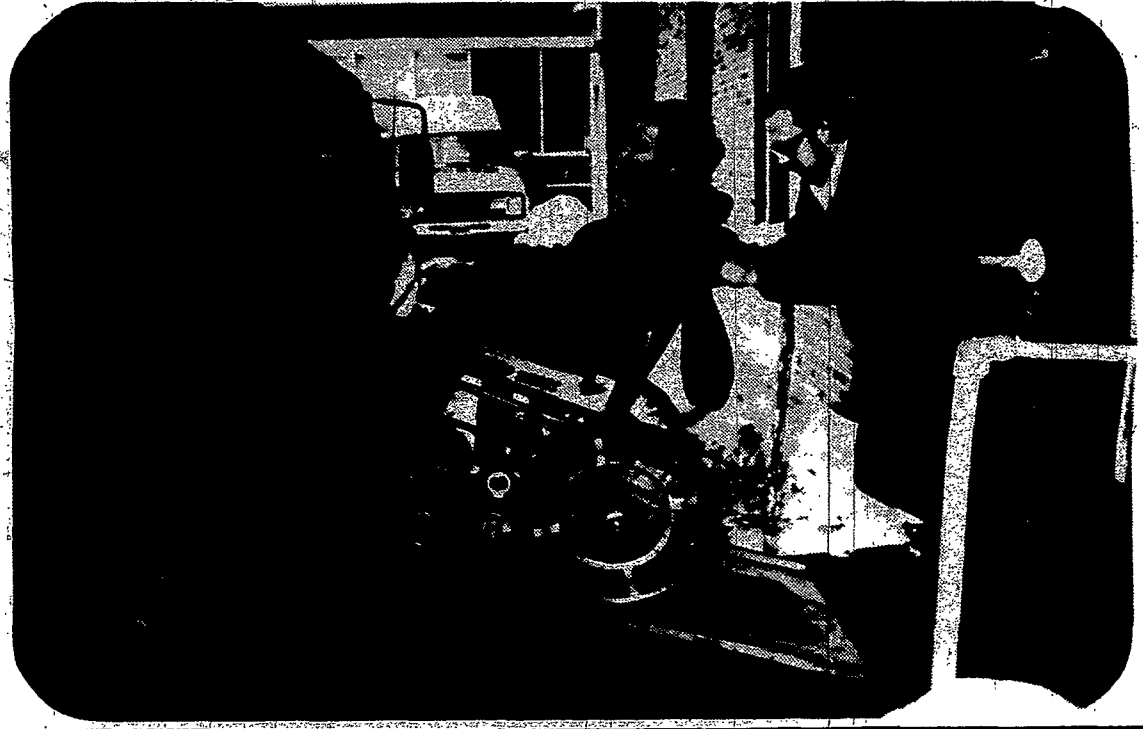




Medicab driver Doug Wagner helps Sam Giambra with his coat before taking Sam to his class at Monroe Community College.

Unique Parish

The parish council, formed about five years ago, is also responsible for organizing a number of charitable benefits, she noted.
