## Pediatrician to Speak On Sexuality

Dr. Eugene F. Diamond, a pediatrician, author, professor and co-founder of Birthright of Chicago in 1971, will be the principal speaker when the St. Thomas More Lawyers Guild presents a program on The Casualties of the Sexual Revolution - Teenagers and Parents at 8 p.m. Monday, April 17 at the Academy of Medicine, 1441 East Ave.

The program will deal with some of the techniques used by the federally-funded population control

groups working with teenagers in the Rochester area. Also to be discussed will be an evaluation of the federal contraceptive-abortion approach to the problem of teenage sexuality, and whether such programs serve as an effective deterrent to teenage promiscuity and pregnancies.

Joseph C. DeMaria, president of the St. Thomas More Guild, said that several prominent churchmen and physicians have

raised serious concern over present approaches to teenagers which do not give them the benefit of a moral value perspective or parental guidance.

DeMaria cited recent medical cases by Dr. Matthew J. Bulfin and the March 10, 1978, Congressional Record which showed that the highest rate of medical complications from abortions including death occurred in teenagers. Other complications cited rising out of this surgical procedure on teenagers were injuries to the cervix or uterus, infection, bleeding, fever, sterility, increased risk of later ectopic pregnancies, increased risk of later spontaneous abortions, increased risk of later stillbirth, and increased risk of later premature birth.

DeMaria said the guild board of directors agree with a recent article by Archbishop Joseph L. Bernardin, former president of the National Conference of Bishops, in the New York Times stating that the present federal approach of massive dissemination of free contraceptives and abortions to teenagers without parental knowledge is a "cheap solution" which shortchanges the real development of a teenager.

The purpose of the April 17 forum, according to DeMaria, is to inform the public, particularly parents, of the material, ideas, and facilities being presented to their children, and hopefully to acquaint them with some of the moral, legal and medical consequences through an articulate and knowledgeable speaker on the subject.

## Development Director Named at Seminary

Nimr S. Ibrahim has been named director of development at St. Bernard's Seminary, according to Father Frank E. Lioi, rector.

Father Lioi said that Ibrahim will assume duties carried out for the past year by Thomas Banaszewski, the seminary's business manager, who has been acting development director.

A native of Jerusalem, Ibrahim is 35 years old and received his BA in European History and a Normal Diploma in Education at American University in Beirut, Lebanon, in 1963 and

a master's degree in the same field two years later. He is a candidate for a Ph.D.

He has written several books on modern Middle Eastern history and world affairs for UNESCO, as well as numerous articles on current events.

"The Office of Development," he said, "is responsible for making clear to the public the mission of St. Bernard's Seminary and obtaining wider recognition, acceptance and support of that mission."

He is married to Marion Schickel of Ithaca.

And the dog demonstrates she can follow "heel" and "stay" instructions;

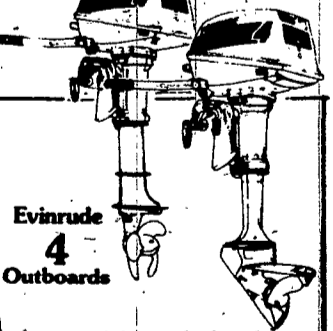
- And the second grader's fever subsides;
