North Region

The North Region is planning a special assembly on Tuesday, May 9 at St. Margaret Mary's Church beginning at 7 p.m. Bishop Joseph L. Hogan will celebrate the Eucharist for the region. Three workshops will be held afterward.

The focus of the evening will be the Bishop's "New Directions 1978-79."

Guest speakers for the workshops and their topics are: Rev. Mr. Daniel O'Shea, "unchurched" people; Father James Schwartz, sacredness of life; and Sister Kathleen Kircher, small communities.

This assembly is open to all parish councils, committees, and all interested parishioners of the North Region.

Southeast Region

John Dollinger, from St. John the Evangelist (Humboldt St.), has been elected to the Diocesan Pastoral Council (DPC) by the Southeast Regional assembly. He joins John Kennedy and Clem Bayer who are already serving as representatives.

A resolution protesting the granting of loans by banks, which "provide financial support" to South Africa which still practices apartheid was presented to the Regional Assembly by Sister Grace Miller. The resolution, which also calls upon "member parishes and parishioners to withdraw funds from Citibank, Chase Manhattan Bank, Chemical Bank, and Manufacturers Trust, and to inform the banks of the reason for the withdrawal" was tabled pending consideration by the parish councils and the Justice and Peace Commission.

Regional Human Development chairpersons, who are working on ways to help St. Bridget's parish, have slated their next meeting for May 11 at 8 p.m.

The region has announced that the Southeast Divorced, Separated and Widowed Catholics group will continue to meet at St. John's parish center. The group has met at the parish since its inception.

Proposal Defeated

A shareholders' proposal that the Eastman Kodak Co. and its subsidiaries do not enter into contracts or renew existing contracts with the South African government was defeated last week at the annual shareholders' meeting in Flemington, N.J. The proposal, signed by a number of religious groups, garnered the approval of only 5 per cent of the other shareholders. However, because more than 3 per cent did approve, the issue may be raised at next year's meeting.

Newcomers 'Dream' Of Parish as Family
