In Albany, Gov. Hugh Carey's veto of the death penalty has withstood an attempt by the State Senate to override. By a vote of 39-19, one short of the necessary two thirds needed to override a veto, those advocating the death penalty lost for this session.

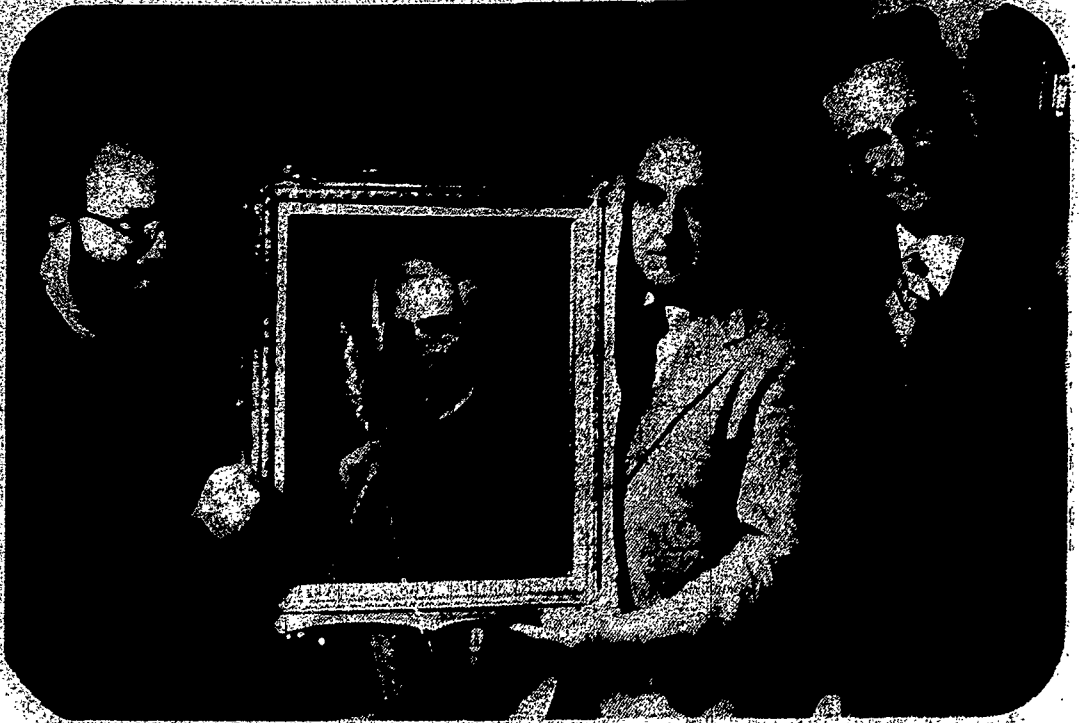

## Portrait Presented

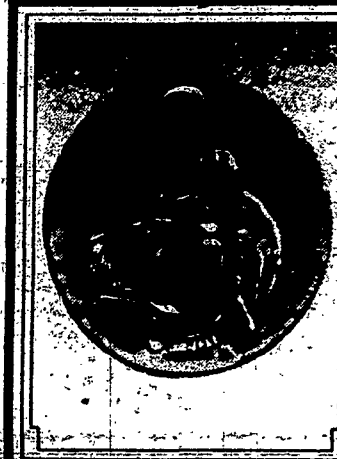
