## Nazareth Receives Grant

Nazareth College has received a \$394,000 grant to continue development of the area's first upper-division baccalaureate program specifically designed for registered nurses, President Robert A. Kidera announced.

The Bureau of Health Manpower, Department of Health Education and Welfare, has notified the college's nursing department that approximately \$167,000 is authorized for program staffing and equipment during the period June 1, 1978 to

May 31, 1979 and an additional 227,000 has been recommended for the project's second year.

The Nazareth nursing program, which leads to a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in nursing, was initiated last September with approximately 100 nurses enrolled full or part time.

Total enrollment has doubled since then and the college expects the equivalent of 150 full-time nursing students by 1980.

## Softball Tourney

The American Cancer Society of Livingston County will sponsor two fund-raising softball tournaments (Class C) for men and women this July.

Helen Stefano, an ACS staffer, said that the men's competition is scheduled for July 8-9 in York, N.Y. The women's tournament will take place in Mt. Morris on July 29-30.

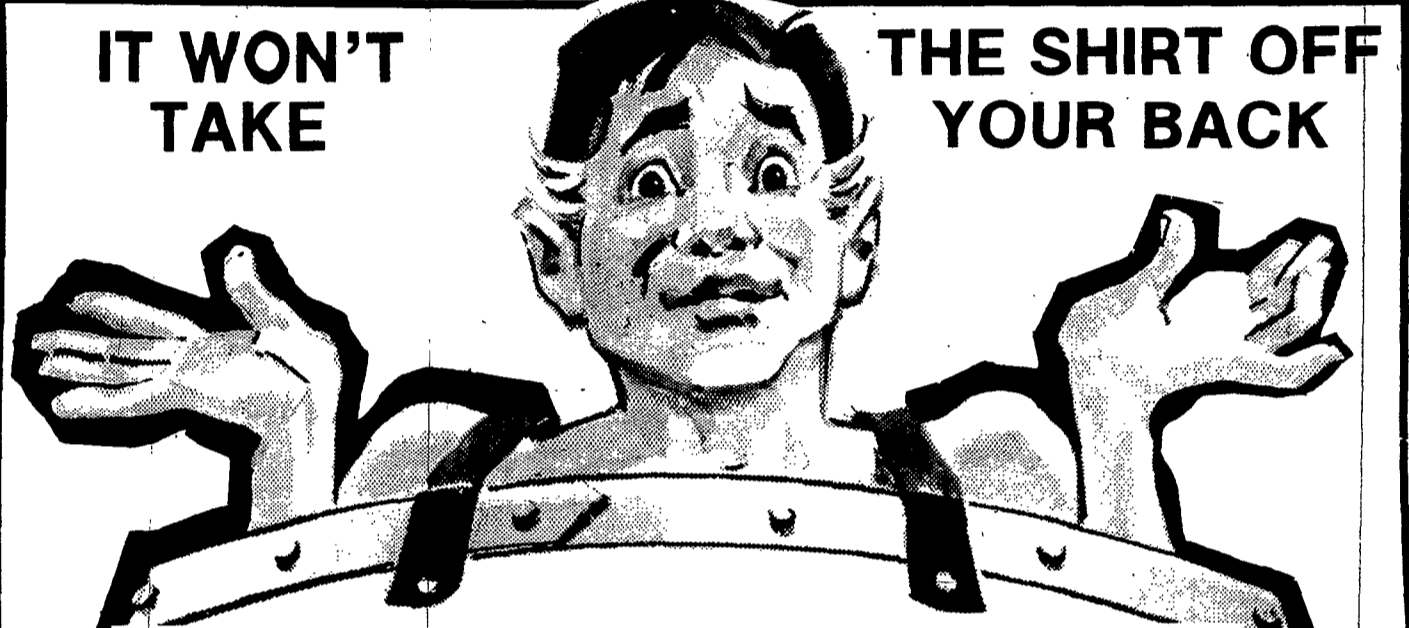
