

\$30,897 Raised For Food Program

The International Justice and Peace Commission for the diocese announced the results of Operation Breadbox for 1978 last week. The "consciousness-raising and fund development" program raised \$30,897.42 which will be disbursed to three impoverished areas in the world as well as to each diocesan region.

The amount donated this year represents an increase of \$3,021.71 from Breadbox '77 with "approximately 85 diocesan parishes participating," according to Ms. Francine Patella, a Justice and Peace Commission spokesperson.

Seventy-five percent (\$23,458.58) will be sent to Macuspana, Mexico; Gorom-Gorom in Upper Volta, Africa; and the Sayangun Catholic Mission in the Philippines. The money will be used for "long-term, self-help, agrarian projects," Patella said. A report on how the money was spent by the International Justice and Peace Commission's worldwide organization is due in August, she said.

The remaining twenty-five percent (\$7,438.84) has been distributed to the 10 regional coordinators

for use in similar projects. The actual amount given to each region depended on how much money the individual region donated. Reports on how that money was used are forthcoming. None of the money donated was used for administrative costs.

Ms. Patella said that plans for Operation Breadbox, for 1979, are already underway. The Justice and Peace Commission's goal this year will be to enlist seventy-five percent of all parishes in the diocese in the program.

She added that the commission is "very pleased to see the increase in participating parishes and very happy about the increase in the total amount donated."

"We hope to be even more effective in 1979," she said.
