# Special Family Dining

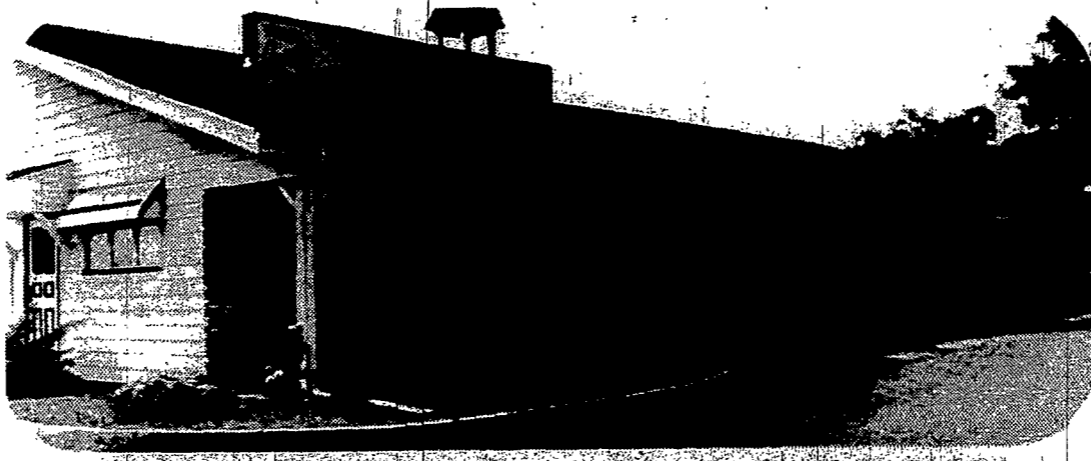

Lou Niger and the late Vince Gentile, former owners of the Brook House on Ridge Road, built the Elmbrook in 1976. It is a neat brick building at the corner of Buffalo and Elmgrove Roads, easily accessible by expressway.

Kevin Mahoney heads a kitchen staff which prepares a variety of steaks, chops, veal dishes, and Italian pastas. They also whip up family specials Monday thru Thursday nights, which the children can have for a dollar. Friday night at the Elmbrook brings a terrific fish fry, also available in children's portions.

Special entrees are not limited to the dinner menu. Luncheon dishes include chopped sirloin, and open prime rib on garlic toast.

The bar is ably manned by Marc Berry and John Harina, retired Rochester Fire Department Captain. Weekend entertainment is provided by songstress Mary Jane Telez. The Elmbrook is open for lunch Monday through Saturday from 11:30 to 2. Dinner is served from 5 to 10 on weekdays and Saturday to 11. Luncheon parties to 50 are catered. Lunch, dinner, and party menus are complemented by a



limited but select wine list. Dinners, inclusive of wine, range from \$3.25 to \$8.50.

The Elmbrook Inn is a quiet, family restaurant, which is run by people with obvious experience in creating an easy atmosphere and fine food for a price which will suit everyone.
