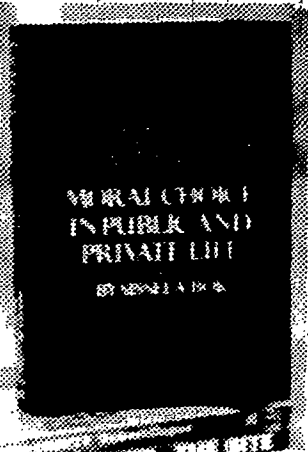

Busing Bill13

The State Legislature convenes on Aug. 8 and will tackle Sen. Fred Eckert's (R-Greece) bill which proposes that the State reimburse 90 per cent of the City's busing expenses at the beginning of the school year rather than at the end. The costs stem from transporting Rochester children to private and parochial schools outside city limits. Though the legislation is only for a year (1978-79), if it passes it will solve the problem for the time being of the busing dilemma which occurred when the Rochester Board of Education cut \$6 million from its budget

working at the "grass roots" level, actually dealing with people and their problems. He also expects that the sisters will be able to provide parish human development committees with good information concerning local needs.

The project is a significant effort to "cut down parish boundaries," Father Schmidt observed. He doesn't expect the sisters to divide their time equally among the parishes, he explained, but to respond to the needs of the whole county. The important thing, he said, is that the sisters will represent the "Church being visible on the streets and the back roads of the county."

He added that the sisters' ministry as females also will be beneficial, noting that they are "just by nature better equipped" to deal with some people. The "mercy, compassion" necessary for such work should be "right up their alley," he said.

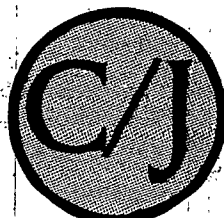
Father Weis, a former regional coordinator and a Tioga County pastor of 15 months, added that he was "very happy and pleased with the response of the parishes" to the proposal. "It's nice to come into an area," he said, "and see positive things happening."

against artificial insemination, Father Haering said, "This is quite different from artificial insemination with the sperm of a donor. This is completely with the biological parents and all the expression of love in this case tended toward the desire for children."

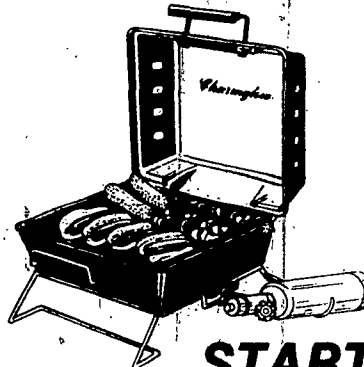
