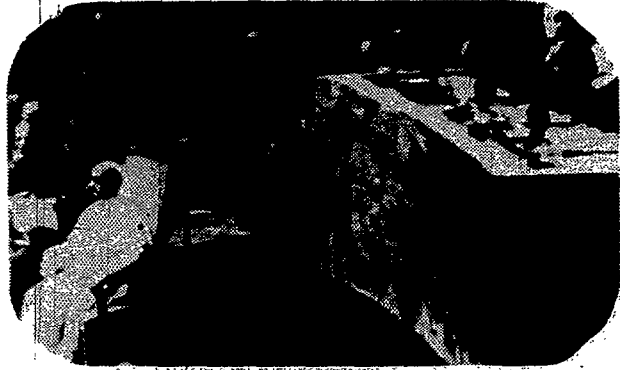


Pope Paul's Life and Times
