Stephen J. Powers of the class of 1969, a probation training consultant for New York State, was chosen as vice president. All other officers



Novena to St. Jude

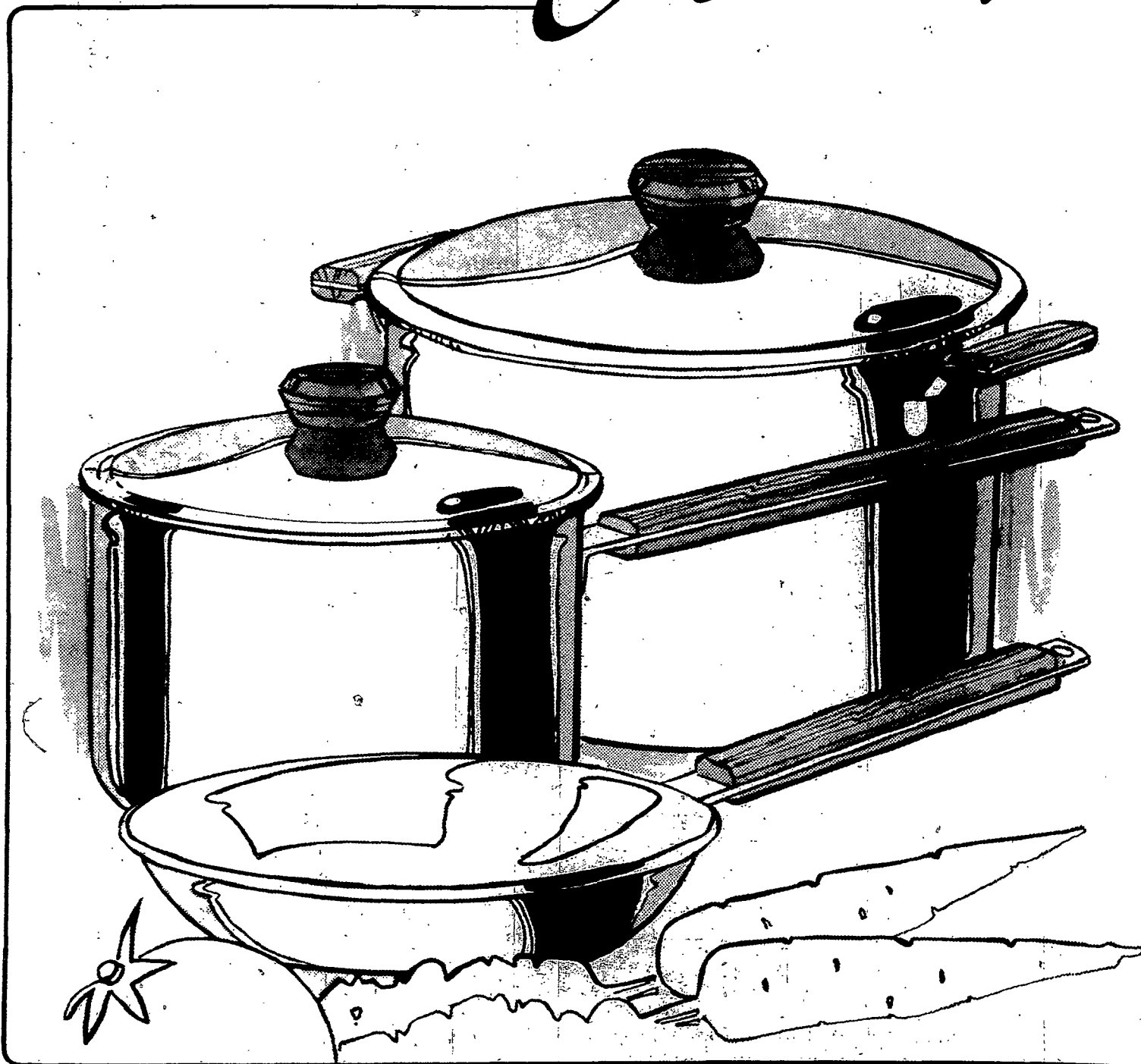
From Oct. 20-28 at St. Jude's Church, 4100 Lyell Rd. Gates, with Mass and prayers each evening at 7:30
