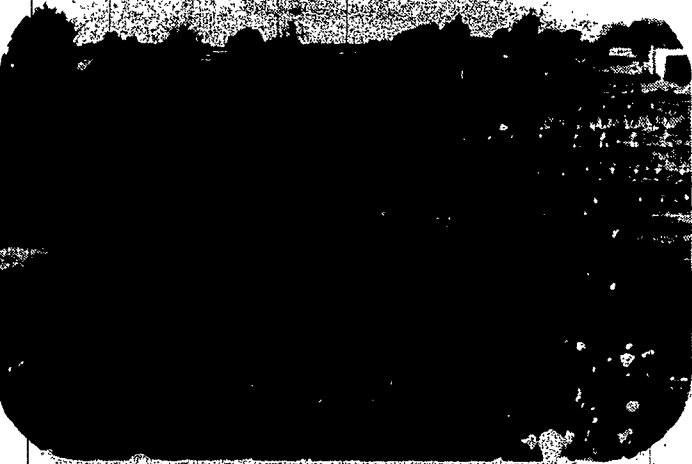




Knights' Gift

Documentary on CBS Dec. 3

Titled "In the Lord's Service," the documentary will be broadcast nationwide Sunday, Dec. 3 at 10:30 a.m. Stations broadcasting the show include WHEC, channel 10, Rochester.

Portsmouth Abbey School is a college preparatory school

for boys, founded by a community of Benedictine monks who form part of its faculty. The program follows the boys into the classroom, at student activities, during sports and recreation.

Portsmouth Abbey has 250 boys in grades 8 through 12, of whom approximately 200 are boarding students. It aims at promoting academic excellence and intellectual growth in its students, while trying to give them a sense of their heritage, both cultural and religious. It is unique among secondary boarding schools in being sponsored by a Benedictine Monastery.
