# Sister Juliana O'Hara **Elected to State Post**

Elmira-Sister Juliana O'Hara, SSJ, director of the Chemung County Office of Aging, has been elected president of the state Association of Area Agencies on Aging.

Sister Juliana, a member of the association's executive committee since the group's founding in 1973, and currently first vice president, will begin her one-year term of office Jan. 17.

"We're very proud" of the association, Sister Juliana commented, noting that "we have no paid staff." Especially Especially noteworthy, she said, is that the executive committee, which she now will chair, meets monthly with the executive staff of the state Department on Aging to discuss policy and legislation.

The statewide association has quarterly meetings, and works for better legislation on the state evel, she said. The group's influence is "power both for the aging," and for administrative concerns, she noted.

Members also participate in a sharing of ideas. She related that she had just recently been in contact with the director in Dutchess County concerning a program in use there which is being planned for Chemung County.

also admitted that the election is "an honor and a vote of confidence" for herself, adding that since the election she has received calls from other agency directors offering assistance.

As president, Sister Juliana also will represent the state at regional and national meetings.
