

Camp Stella Maris Opens 53rd Season

Coneus Lake — Camp Stella Maris begins its fifty-third camping season with an open house on June 10 for parents who wish to tour the grounds and meet the staff of

both boys and girls encampments. The open house will be from 1-5 p.m.

This year's camping season will begin with the boys camping on July 1. The girls camping will begin on July 29.

Stella Maris has made some changes this year. It has moved the camp office from the Catholic Charities Office on Chestnut Street in Rochester to the camp grounds on 3052 East Lake Rd., Livonia. Ray Tette, camp director, explained that the move will provide a much more efficient program. The Stella Maris facilities are used year round now compared with the two month summer session.

The camp is also taking advantage of the computer operation at the diocesan Office of Pastoral Planning. Camping applications will be sent directly to the Pastoral Office on Buffalo Road and reservations can be processed much more efficiently, Tette said.

Reservations are now being accepted for the two camping sessions. Tette suggested that interested parents make the reservations early. He expects the camp to host a larger number of campers than ever before.

AOH Fund Drive To Be Launched On Saint's Day

A money-raising effort aimed at preserving the Irish heritage in America will be launched on St. Patrick's Day at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City. Members of the Ancient Order of Hibernians and its Ladies Auxiliary will gather after the 10 a.m. Mass to receive the blessing of Cardinal Terence Cooke on their endeavor to raise \$1.3 million.

The money will provide an endowment for the Center for the Study of American Catholicism at the University of Notre Dame. Among those directing the drive is Thomas D. McNabb of Auburn, national president. Other New Yorkers involved are M. Josephine Ahern of Kings Park and Walter H. Crowley of Elmhurst. About 17,000 Hibernians in the United States will be asked to take part.

The Notre Dame center was established in 1976 to capitalize on the University's extensive library and archives relating to the history of the Church in this country.
