But to backtrack: the occasion of the prayer came shortly after her husband of four months died of cancer.

She said that her husband, too, was a recovered alcoholic, and despite the ex-cruciating pain of the cancer he had, refused to take alcohol. "I'm going to die sober, Irene," he told his bride. "I'm going to die nobly.

She said that at her husband's funeral, friends of hers, also recovered alcoholics, marvelled both at her husband's and her determination to endure the ordeal sober. "If you can get through that without a drink, you can get through anything," a friend told her.

Ms. Costigan agrees.

She said that she feels the prayer is a direct inspiration from God, to help alcoholics. She said that as she wrote the prayer, she felt that "God wanted the prayer published and chose me as a vehicle."

The prayer appears on a small calling card, and is being distributed by The Hazelden Press in Min-


