Tuition Hikes Set For Area Colleges

When the tuition hikes were announced last week by the Rochester Region Commission on Independent Colleges and Universities, it was also revealed that even with the new tuition rates, St. John Fisher College and Nazareth College are the least expensive schools for day-students in the area.

St. John Fisher's tuition next year will be \$3,415; and Nazareth's, \$3,100.

The other schools in the organization are Eisenhower College, Keuka College, Rochester Institute of Technology, University of Rochester, Wells College and Hobart-William Smith College.

The tuition hikes were announced at a press conference chaired by Nazareth president, Robert A. Kidera, who took the occasion to call on the state's lawmakers to

increase the annual state funding to private colleges.

The commission is asking the state to increase its aid from \$5,272,610 to \$6,985,200.
