Father Richard Wagner, S.S.J., pastor of Prince of Peace Church in Mobile, Alabama, has been elected Josephite area director for the Diocese of Mobile; Birmingham, Alabama; Jackson, Mississippi; Biloxi, Mississippi; St. Augustine, Florida; Archdiocese of Miami, Florida; and the diocese of Nassau in the Bahamas.

Father Wagner is a native of Rochester and is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Francis Wagner. He was elected to the directorship by the Josephite priests and Brothers in that geographical area.

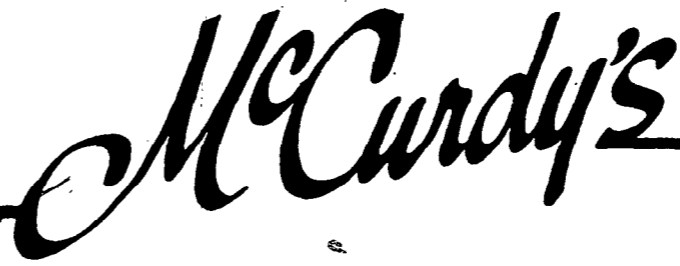

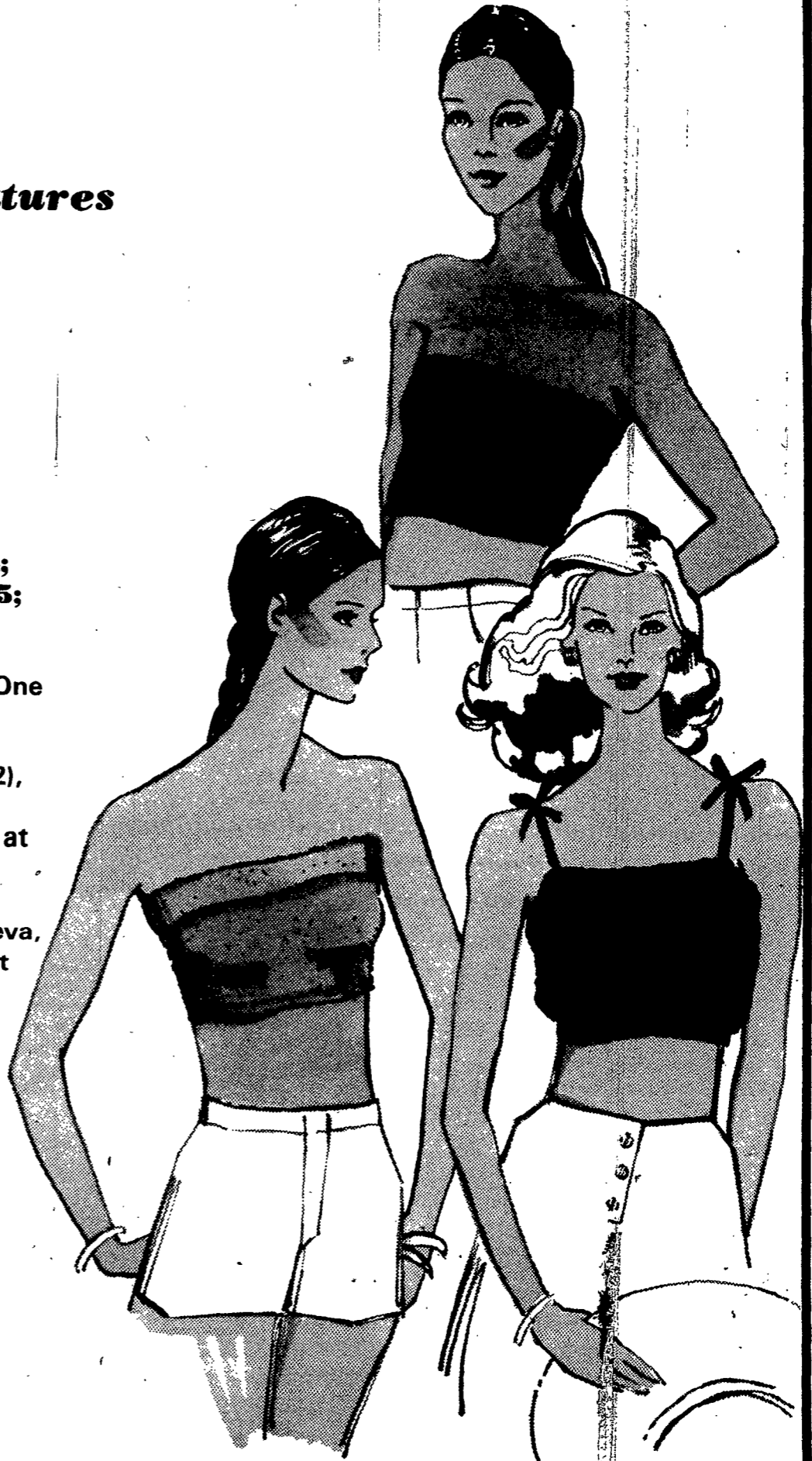
