Bishop Clark's Curriculum Vitae

Born July 15, 1937, at Waterford, N.Y., son of M. Harvey Clark (deceased) and Grace Bills Clark.

Educated at Public School 1, Waterford; Catholic Central High School, Troy; Holy Cross College, Worcester, Mass.; Mater Christi Seminary, Albany; St. Bernard's Seminary, Rochester; North American College, Rome; Gregorian University, Rome.

Ordained Dec. 19, 1962, in Rome, Church of Christ the King, by Bishop Martin O'Connor.

1963— Awarded graduate degree in theology, Gregorian University, Rome.

September, 1963-August, 1964— Served at Our Lady of Mercy Parish, Albany, while teaching at Vincentian Institute, Albany.

1964-1966— Returned to Gregorian University for Canon Law studies; received degree 1966.

1966-1967— Vice Chancellor, Albany Diocese; Newman Chaplain, Albany Law School.

1967-1972— Assistant pastor, St. Ambrose, Latham.

1969-1972— Chairman, Priests Personnel Board, Albany.

1972-1974— Assistant Spiritual Director, North American College, Rome.

1974-1979— Spiritual Director, North American College, Rome.

1975— Awarded doctorate in spirituality, Gregorian University, Rome.

May 2, 1979— Public announcement in Rochester that Pope John Paul II had appointed Father Matthew H. Clark to be Bishop of Rochester.

May 27, 1979— Ordained a bishop by Pope John Paul II in St. Peter's Basilica, Rome.

June 26— Installed as eighth Bishop of Rochester at public ceremony in Rochester's Community War Memorial.
