Our prayers, talents and labors are freely given to you on this, the greatest occasion of our life.

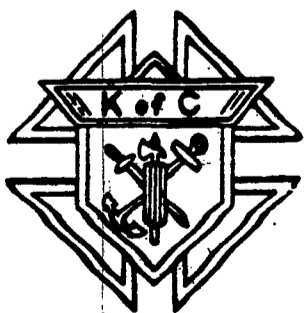
