## St. Rita's, W. Webster

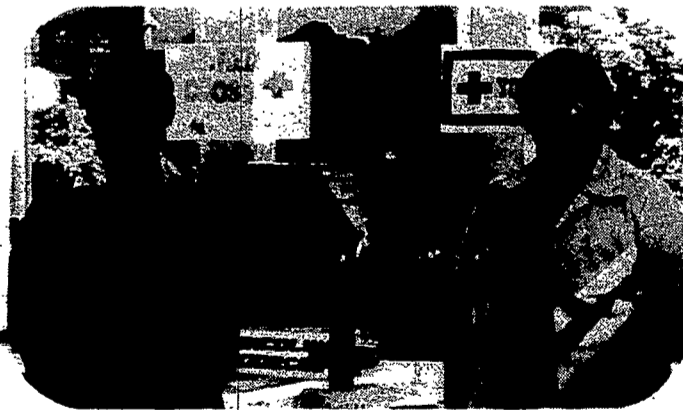
