High Court: Parents Can't Veto Minor's Right to Abort

Washington (RNS) — An unmarried, underaged woman's decision to have an abortion cannot be arbitrarily vetoed, either by parents or by judges, the Supreme Court ruled here.

The high court's judgment strikes down a Massachusetts law enacted in 1974 requiring that unmarried women under age 18 obtain both parents' permission or, failing that, secure permission from a Superior Court judge to have an abortion.

The Supreme Court action is its second in three years on the subject. In 1976, the court ruled that a Missouri law requiring the consent of one parent violated the minor woman's right to privacy in the decision to have an abortion.

Six years ago, Jan. 22, 1973, the court ruled that the decision to terminate a pregnancy during the first trimester is protected by the right to privacy and that a woman in consultation with her physician may make the decision.
