# Parish Finds Stewardship a Formula for Success

Owego - Wanted: A formula to increase volunteers in the parish, increase interest in new parish groups, cause spiritual benefits, generally increase parish spirit, and, coincidentally, increase weekly offertory collections.

St. Patrick's Parish found that formula last year when they began the Stewardship program with the assistance of the diocese, Now they are involved in their second campaign, and they don't expect it to be their last.

St. Patrick's co-pastors, Father Thomas Watts and Father Albert Cason, and the campaign's lay leaders will list the benefits they see from last year's effort, if you have the time to listen .

Two couples, Pat and Dick Franz and Joan and Bob Dizer headed the program last year. Joining them this year are Barb and Howard Enkling, who will head the program next year with another couple new to the chairmanship. The idea is for a new couple to learn the jobs one year, and teach the next.

Probably more than 200

volunteers will be involved this year. They will visit about 900 parish families on the Sundays of Oct. 14 and 21.

The personal visit is important, they noted. Father Cason said that for some, it was the first time someone representing the Church had visisted them. That provided an opportunity for some to express their disapproval of changes in the Church. Father Watts noted that for some, having someone listen to their concerns was important. On the follow up, he added, he saw persons who, after having said what was on their mind, were willing to listen. Father Cason noted that some of those persons are attending Mass again; others are closer to doing so.

Interest expressed on Stewardship cards was sufficient to start a convert class, they said, and seven persons were baptized.

Also added following the drive was a Bible study class for adults on Sundays during the children's classes. Attendance at religious education classes also increased, Mrs. Enkling said.

A Buildings and Grounds

Committee, which had gone out of existence, was reformed, and took the lead this past summer when the old cafeteria in the school was renovated for use as a kindergarten.

The Stewardship drive also increased both the number of persons distributing Communion to shut-ins on Sundays, and the number receiving Communion at home, Father Watts added.

Mrs. Dizer commented that the greatest benefit was the "parish spirit" that grew from the Stewardship effort.

Mrs. Dizer noted that the "help from the diocese was invaluable," and that they "knew they could get help with a phone call" to the diocese.

Father Cason reported that of the "three T's," Time, Talent and Treasure, last year the drive purposely down-played the treasure segment. But true to predictions that families involved in their parish will support it financially, the collections went up anyway.

This year, Father Cason

noted, they will treat



"treasure" as equal to the other two, but not any more important.

Asked if they intend to

continue the program in future years, the priests and workers had no hesitation in answering yes. The work being done on the program

makes it obvious that the intention is that Stewardship will be a permanent part of parish life at St. Patrick's.
