Kollar Reports On Trip to Mass

"An experience unlike any other" was how Judith Ann Kollar, Diocesan Pastoral Council executive secretary, described her participation in the papal Mass on the Mall in Washington Sunday, Oct. 7.

Mrs. Kollar was an official representative, invited as one of 100 lay people from various dioceses to sit in a particular section at the Mass.

The Mass occurred on the final day of Pope John Paul II's visit to the United States.

Mrs. Kollar noted that she spoke with Secret Service agents who said that the crowd for the Mass, estimated at 175,000, was one of the most orderly they had ever seen. "People just seemed to be happy," Mrs. Kollar commented.

The atmosphere was exceptional, she said. Those in the seating had been told to bring food with them, and, when the pope was late, two Monsignors led the crowd in the recitation of the rosary. She said that the result was people sitting around on the grass, eating and praying.

Mrs. Kollar reported that she could tell from the noise made by the crowds lining Independence Avenue that

the pope was approaching. Near her in the seating were Eunice Shriver and her son, she recalled.
